

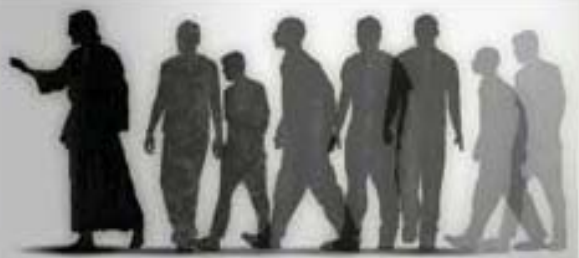

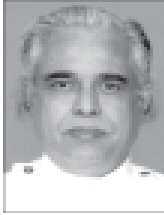

തിരുവനന്തപുരം ക്രൈസ്റ്റ് ചർച്ച് കുടുംബത്തിലേക്ക് എന്നേയും, എന്റെ കുടുംബത്തേയും സസന്തോഷം സ്വീകരിക്കുകയും, ഞങ്ങളുടെ ക്രിസ്തീയ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളിൽ സഹായിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യുന്ന നിങ്ങളേവർക്കും നന്ദി കരേറുന്നു.

ജൂൺ മാസം പലവിധേന പ്രാധാന്യമുള്ള ഒന്നാണ്. വിദ്യാർത്ഥി ഞായർ (പ്രവേശനോത്സവം, വിദ്യാരംഭം), പരിസ്ഥിതി ഞായർ, രക്തസാക്ഷി ദിനങ്ങൾ തുടങ്ങിയ അനേകം ആഘോഷങ്ങൾ ഈ മാസം നടക്കുന്നുണ്ട്. ജൂണിന്റെ പ്രഥമദിനം പ്രവേശനോത്സവമായി സംസ്ഥാനമാകെ ആഘോഷിക്കുന്നു; ഒരു നൂതനാദ്ധ്യായം തുറക്കുന്നു. ദൈവവചനം ഉദ്ഘോഷിക്കുന്നു “യഹോവാദേകതി ജ്ഞാനത്തിന്റെ ആരംഭമാകുന്നു”. നമ്മുടെ കുഞ്ഞുങ്ങൾ ദൈവദേഹത്തിൽ മുതിർന്നുവരുവാനും സ്വർഗ്ഗീയജ്ഞാനം കരസ്ഥമാക്കുവാനും, അങ്ങനെ തങ്ങളെ അഭിമുഖീകരിക്കുന്ന പ്രശ്നങ്ങളെ നേരിടുവാനും ദൈവം കൃപ ചെയ്യട്ടെ.

പ്രപഞ്ചം ദൈവവകയാണ്; അത് സംരക്ഷിക്കുവാനും, കൈകാര്യം ചെയ്യുവാനുമുള്ള ഉത്തരവാദിത്തം ദൈവം നമ്മെ ഏല്പിച്ചിരിക്കുന്നു.

ജൂൺ, അപ്പോസ്തലന്മാരുടേയും, രക്തസാക്ഷികളുടേയും മാസമായും ആചരിക്കപ്പെടുന്നു. രക്തസാക്ഷികളുടെ രക്തമാണ് സഭയുടെ വിത്ത് എന്ന് പറയാറുണ്ടല്ലോ. അതേ; സഭയുടെ നിലനില്പുതന്നെ, നമ്മുടെ കർത്താവായ യേശുക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ വിലയേറിയ രക്തത്തിന്റേയും, അപ്പോസ്തലന്മാരുടെ രക്തത്തിന്റേയും, അടിസ്ഥാനത്തിലത്രേ. വിശുദ്ധ ബർന്നബാസ്, സ്നാപക യോഹന്നാൻ വിശുദ്ധ പത്രോസ്, വിശുദ്ധ പൗലോസും, പന്ത്രണ്ടു ശിഷ്യന്മാരും എന്നിവരുടെ ജീവിതവും, സാക്ഷ്യവും അനുസ്മരിക്കുന്ന സമയമാണ് ജൂൺ മാസം. ഇവരെ കുറിച്ചുള്ള വിശുദ്ധ ഓർമ്മകൾ നമ്മുടെ ജീവിതത്തിൽ പ്രത്യേക ശക്തി പകരുവാനും, നമുക്കെതിരെ വരുന്ന വെല്ലുവിളികളെ അഭിമുഖീകരിക്കുവാനും ഇടയായിതീരട്ടെ.

ആരാണ് യഥാർത്ഥ ശിഷ്യൻ? ഉത്തരം വളരെ ലഘുവാണ്; ശിഷ്യപ്പെടുന്നവനാണ് ശിഷ്യൻ. അതായത് ഗുരുവിന് വിധേയപ്പെടുന്നവൻ, മഹാഗുരുവായ നമ്മുടെ കർത്താവ് പറഞ്ഞു : ‘ആരെങ്കിലും എന്റെ ശിഷ്യനാകുവാൻ ഇച്ഛിച്ചാൽ അവൻ തന്നത്താൻ ത്യജിച്ച്; തന്റെ ക്രൂശ് എടുത്തുകൊണ്ട് എന്നെ അനുഗമിക്കട്ടെ’. അവൻ നമുക്ക് വാഗ്ദത്തം ചെയ്യുന്നത് സന്തോഷത്തിന്റെ പൂമെത്തയല്ല, പ്രത്യുത കുരിശും, മുറിവും, കഷ്ടതയും ഒക്കെയാണ്.

ജോൺ എം. നീൽ എഴുതിയ ‘നീ ക്ഷീണിച്ചോ, നീ വലഞ്ഞോ’ എന്ന അനശ്വരഗാനത്തിലെ നാലു വരികൾ, ശിഷ്യത്വത്തിന്റെ അന്തസത്തയെ പ്രതിഫലിപ്പിക്കുന്നതാണ്.

Environment Sunday Special**GREEN GOSPEL****Christian Concern for Ecological Degradation**

“Christians ought to be stewards of God’s good earth”. The Creation story narrates God’s charge to humanity to take care of the blessed earth for everyone to enjoy; but humanity got out of control resulting in chaos in the created universe and therefore God sought to restore order by cleansing the earth with the Great Flood.

All over the world, animal and plant species are disappearing now at an unprecedented and alarming rate. Biologists predict that half of all the species on the earth will disappear within 100 years. If we continue fishing at the present rate, the seafood will also disappear by 2050.

In this context, the concept of Green Church is based on Christ’s call to be “A City on the Hill”, bearing witness and preserving the creation as an example to the rest of the world.

Products of Ecological Degradation

Toxic waste, Polluted water, Acid rain, Greenhouse gases and resultant Global warming, Landslides, Earthquakes and Tsunamis are the products of Ecological degradation.

The serious destruction of the environment during the last 40 years has compelled the Churches to address this issue and come up with a theological understanding about creation, about the ill effects of technology and development on the environment.

Pollution of water, air and land, and large scale felling of trees resulting in desertification, exploitation of non-renewable natural resources such as oil, minerals, soil, rock, forest etc. changes the eco system and the ozone layer.

Theological Perspectives on justice, participation and sustainability of the Ecosystem

Sustainability in the Bible is faithfulness to God’s creation, preserving it from destruction, leading to fullness of abundant life. We have received God’s Earth as a common inheritance, not as a privilege for some and a source of fortune for others.

The eleventh commandment therefore, should be “The Earth is the Lord’s; and the fullness thereof. Therefore, thou shall not spoil the Earth, nor destroy the life thereon”.

The gradual depletion of the ozone layer and related “green house effect” has now reached crisis proportions as a consequence of rapid industrial growth, massive urban concentration and vastly increased energy needs. Industrial waste, the burning of fossil fuels, unrestricted deforestation, the use of certain types of herbicides, coolants and propellants – all these are known to harm the atmosphere and the environment.

The Earth is God’s gift to all creatures. But the earth does not yield its fruits without a particular human response to God’s gift: that is to say, without work. But it is through certain types of work that man succeeds in demolishing the Earth

The Church has, therefore, to condemn ‘consumerism’ and ‘the culture of waste’ and a spirit of solidarity is to be developed, grounded in our common responsibility for the Earth and for all our brothers and sisters in the human family.

There are other weak and defenceless beings that are frequently at the mercy of economic interests or indiscriminate exploitation of natural resources. Human beings are not only the beneficiaries, but also the stewards of other creatures. Thanks to our bodies, God has joined us so closely to the world around us that we can feel the desertification of the soil around us, almost as a physical ailment; and the extinction of a species as a painful disfigurement. If we are insensitive to nature’s warnings, a swath of destruction and death will affect our own lives and those of our future generations.

The human family has received from its Creator a common gift, that is, **Nature**. The Christian view of creation includes a positive judgement about the legitimacy of interventions on nature, if these are meant to be beneficial and performed responsibly. By wisely using the resources for the benefit of all, with respect to beauty, finality and usefulness for every living being and its place in the eco system, we can preserve the environment.

Nature, in a word, is at our disposition and we are called to exercise a responsible stewardship over it. This, in my perspective, is the **Green Gospel**.

CHRISTIAN DISCIPLESHIP

“Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will make you fishers of men.” - Matthew 4:19

The first generation disciples of Jesus were called “Christians” at Antioch and as Christians of today it is our legacy. Needless to say that it is important to examine the implications of the name and analyse the duties involved in order to be found worthy of the name.

A disciple is a follower of a master or spiritual teacher, one who lives by the teachings and life style of his master, a learner who wants to be like his master. Jesus said “Ye call me master and Lord and ye say well; for so I am” (John 13:13) “It is enough for the disciple that he be like his master” (Matt 10:25) Christian Discipleship is the process by which disciples grow in the Lord Jesus Christ, and are empowered by the Holy Spirit who lives in our hearts enabling us to overcome the trials and temptations of the present life and become more and more Christ like. As followers of Christ, we have to analyse carefully or test introspectively our thoughts, words and actions daily during our prayer and meditation time and compare them with the word of God. For this purpose we have to study the word of God, pray over it and obey it.

Now let us review what the Bible says as to what is involved in becoming and being a Christian disciple; also consider the conditions or cost of true Christian discipleship.

The call to Discipleship

The decision to follow Jesus Christ marks the beginning of Christian discipleship. Jesus called Levi, the son of Al-phaeus sitting at the receipt of custom (Mark 2:14), Peter and Andrew casting their net into the sea (Matt 4:19,20) and said “follow me”. They immediately followed him, leaving their possessions. In both the cases we see immediate obedience. Jesus himself is the perfect example of obedience as he lived on earth a life of complete obedience to the father, even to the point of death. By this obedience to God one becomes blessed (Phil 2:6-8). The offering of Christ’s body on the cross was the culmination of a life totally lived out in obedience to God (Eph 5:2).

As Christ called his disciples He calls us today “Come, follow me” (Mk. 1:17). Our response should not only be through obeying his commands but also by partaking in His sufferings, death and

resurrection. If we communicate with God earnestly in spirit we will be “conformed to the image of his son”. God desires that each one of us should truly believe in Jesus Christ and enter the life eternal. When we accept him as our Lord and Saviour (John 13:14) we become his disciples, the true Christians.

The purpose of Christian Discipleship

The main aim of Christian discipleship is to emulate the character of Christ in our lives, to be like Him. “To this you were called because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example that you should follow his steps. (1 Peter 2:21).

Another purpose of Christian discipleship is to know the father through Jesus and to grow in our knowledge of God and His grace. The Gospels depict the disciples as those who were given the secret knowledge about the identity of Jesus Christ (Mk 4:9,10; Matt 13:11) Jesus said “those who have seen me have seen the father”.

Yet a third is to have the light of life, and to give light to the world. “for God who made his light shine in our hearts, to give us the light of the knowledge of God’s glory displayed in the face of Christ” (2 Cor. 4:6) “For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works which God prepared in advance for us to do” (Eph 2:10). We can make disciples of others by sharing our faith and the wonderful changes Jesus Christ made in our lives. A true disciple creates other disciples.

Conditions/Cost of Discipleship

Jesus himself did layout the conditions for His discipleship. We must follow Jesus’ teachings.

Self-denial; Cross-bearing

Following Jesus Christ and doing His will should be our first priority in life, above our family and comfort. We must be willing to forsake anything that can hinder our walk with him. We have to leave behind our past life with its weaknesses. Jesus said “those of you who do not give up everything you have, cannot be my disciple” (Lk. 14:33). Jesus taught His disciples to make the pursuit of the kingdom of God their highest priority (Matt 6:23). The life of cross-bearing was therefore a call to die to all one’s selfish ambitions and aspirations. Following him meant serving others just as he gave his life for others. (Mk10 :43-45) “Whoever wants to be my disciples must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me” (Matt 16:24) Jesus said “Whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their

life for me will save it" (Lk. 9:24). All the four gospel writers have recorded these words of Jesus, repeated by two of them in order to emphasise its importance (Matt 10:39, 16:25, Mk. 8:35, Lk. 9:24, 17:33 and John 12:25).

The way of the cross is the way of pain, suffering, ridicule and humiliation. St. Paul chose that path and says "But whatever were gains to me, I now consider loss for the sake of Christ. What is more I consider everything a loss, because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him" (Phil 3:7-9). Moreover we have to crucify our sinful desires. St. Paul says "Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires" (Gal 5:24) Again he says "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me" (Gal 2:20). We have to remember that the present suffering will lead to future glory.

It is God's will that we become more like Christ, and hence hardship and suffering are part of this process. It is said "hard times are the chisel God uses to shape us". "Perseverance must finish its work so that we may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. (James 1:2-4) We must keep in mind that in the midst of life's trials and sorrows, Christ must be the focus of our faith. It was God's plan to shape the lives of those who love Him along the same lines as the life of His son (Rom 8:29). In fact it is the purpose of our life. Love is reciprocative. We can give and receive real love. We can discern right from the wrong, making us accountable to God on the Day of Judgment.

Loving Christ

Loving God follows from knowing God. "You shall love the Lord" is God's commandment, Love is sacrificial, an attribute of God. Our love for Christ is the compelling force to follow Him. St. Paul says "For Christ's love compels us" (2 Cor. 5:14) Jesus says "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My father will love them and we will come to them and make our home with them". (John 14:23). What an assurance!

Loving Others: Love in Action

Love is a gift, a virtue so amazing, so divine, so pure. God loved us so much that "He gave his only Son" to die for us. Jesus said "A new commandment I give you : Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another" (John 13:34). St. Paul says

“Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil, cling to what is good. Be devoted to one another in love. Honour one another above yourselves” (Rom 12:9,10).

Fruitfulness

Jesus said “If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit” (John 15:5). Bearing fruit is a sign of growth and maturity. “This is to my father’s glory that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples (John 15:8). “But the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control (Gal 5:22). When we abide in Christ and obey His commands, the Holy Spirit enables us to produce the fruit. We will start to see a great change in our lives. Our hearts overflow with the purest and finest thoughts which show up in our words and actions, carving the foundations for a righteous living.

Remember, it is possible to be a disciple and finally go to hell. Out of the twelve Jesus chose, there was one who did not make it. He too was listening to the words of Jesus, he had gone out preaching and healing in the name of Jesus (Lk. 9:1,2) and he had left all to follow him. But he (the first treasurer) was faithless in looking after the money of the church; the Bible says, he went to “his own place”.

Living in Hope

As the life of Jesus did not end in crucifixion, life of a Christian does not end with self-denial, suffering and sacrifice. It ends in our resurrection and life with Jesus in His glory in heaven forever. God wants us to come before Him “holy..... without blemish and free from accusation” (1 Thes. 5:27) Death is not the end of life, it is only the gateway to eternity, where “There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain” (Rev. 21:4) God will wipe away every tear from our eyes. It is our glorious hope. “We will be with the Lord forever” (1 Thes 4:17). Ahead of us is the joy of heaven. Therefore we “ought to live holy and godly lives, as you look forward to the day of God” (2 Peter 3:11,12). Praise God for the hope we have in Christ. But until that day God calls us home, let us make it our goal to live for our Saviour Jesus Christ.

God wants us to be a community of Christ’s disciples who translate creed into conduct, faith into practice and doctrine into daily living. Therefore let us strive to live a God-centered, purpose driven life, a life of sincere faith, fervent love and steadfast hope - the life of a true Christian disciple.

In the Annual Report 2014-15 the total Harvest Festival Receipts were shown as Rs.23,44,905/- whereas the total of the breakup of various receipts came to only Rs.22,99,115/- This was due to the accidental omission of one item, Harvest Festival Offertory, amounting to Rs.45,790/- from the breakup of Receipts. In addition, Harvest Festival Auction Receipt of Rs.4,751/- which was received towards the end of March 2015, was not included in the Secretary's Report, which had been prepared earlier. 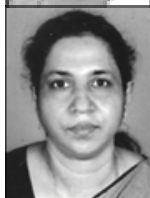

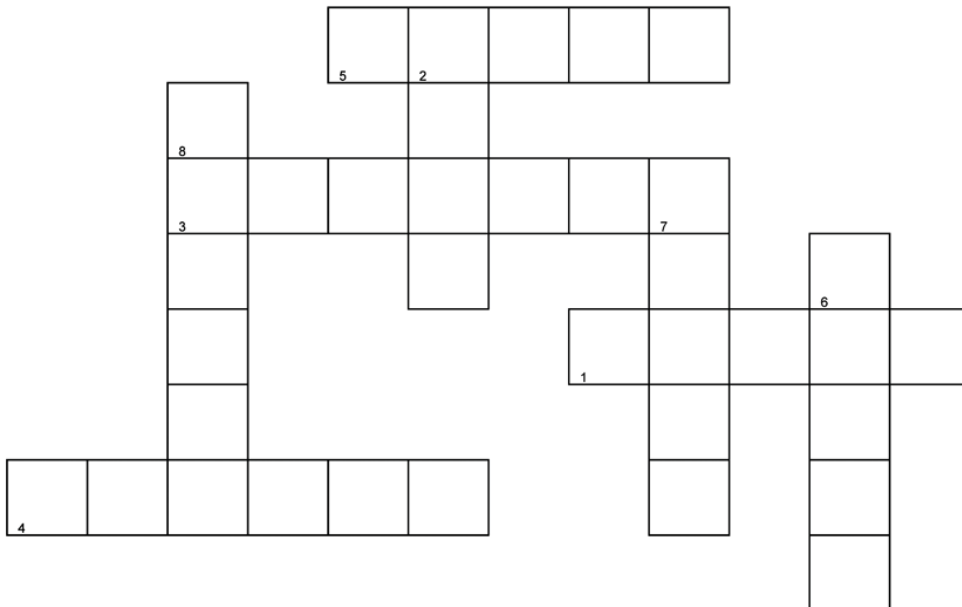
