## Vicar's Reflections

Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.

The first Sunday in October every year is celebrated as Youth Sunday. We hope this will help to inspire and encourage our youth members to come forward and participate in the activities of the Church. The Madhya Kerala Diocesan Youth Movement is one of the first Christian Youth Movements in Asia. It was started by our former missionary Bishop, the Rt. Rev. C.H. Gill in 1916. This year is the centenary year of the Youth Movement. Let us thank and praise God for the inestimable ways in which He has guided the Youth Movement in the past one hundred years.

As children of God we must have a personal salvation experience. When Nicodemus came to Jesus, He said to Nicodemus, "You must be born anew" (John 3:3). Nicodemus was a Pharisee. Pharisees were very keen in observing the Law of Moses, and were much devoted to religious activities. The word translated 'anew' has two other meanings: it can mean 'from above', or it can mean 'for a second time'. To be born anew is such a radical change that it can only be described as a second birth, and it is 'from above' - not the result of human effort, but of the power and grace of God. Nicodemus well knew his need of such a radical change, but it seemed so impossible, like demanding that someone be re-born physically (John 3:4)

The new birth brings a person into the Kingdom of God (John 3: 3,5). The Kingdom of God is not something that has to do only with the life to come. It is the sovereignty of God here on the earth in the lives of His people. The person who is born again lives a life of response to the will of God. No man can do this by his own power, though it does require the response of man to God's power. Jesus put it this way: "Unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God" (John 3:5). Water means cleansing. It is also a symbol of the Word of God and therefore, of obedience to it. The Spirit denotes power. When the Lord saves us and takes possession of our lives, He empowers us to be what we could never be of ourselves. St. Paul says, "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, behold, the new has come." (2 Corinth. 5:17)

Being born again is an intensely practical experience. We can never fully understand how God does His work, but its effects will be obvious to all, like that of the invisible wind whose effects we see and feel (John :8).

Let us thank God for His salvation, and let us pray that its effects may be more and more clearly seen in our lives.

കർത്താവിൽ പ്രിയരേ,

യേശുക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ നാമത്തിൽ സ്നേഹവന്ദനം.

ഒക്ടോബർ ഒന്നാം ഞായർ സാധാരണയായി യുവജന ഞായറായിട്ടാണ് നാം കൊണ്ടാടുന്നത്. സഭയുടെ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളിൽ പങ്കാളികളാകുവാൻ യുവജനങ്ങൾക്ക് പ്രചോദനവും പ്രോത്സാഹനവും യുവജനഞായർ ആചരണത്തിലൂടെ ലഭിക്കുമെന്ന് നാം പ്രതീക്ഷിക്കുന്നു. ഏഷ്യയിലെ ആദ്യത്തെ ക്രിസ്തീയ യുവജനപ്രസ്ഥാനമാണ് മദ്ധ്യകേരള മഹായിടവക യുവജനപ്രസ്ഥാനം. 1916 ൽ മിഷണറി ബിഷപ്പായിരുന്ന സി.എച്ച്. ഗിൽ തിരുമേനിയാണ് യുവജനപ്രസ്ഥാനം ആരംഭിച്ചത്. ഈ വർഷം യുവജന പ്രസ്ഥാനത്തിന്റെ ശതാബ്ദി വർഷമാണ്. കഴിഞ്ഞ നൂറുവർഷം യുവജനപ്രസ്ഥാനത്തെ അത്യധികമായി അനുഗ്രഹിച്ചു വഴി നടത്തിയ ദൈവത്തിനു സ്തോത്രം ചെയ്യാം.

ദൈവമക്കളായ നമുക്കു വ്യക്തിപരമായി രക്ഷ അനുഭവിച്ചറിയുവാൻ കഴിയണം. പരീശപ്രമാണിയായ നിക്കോദെമോസ് യേശുവിന്റെ അടുക്കൽ വന്നപ്പോൾ, യേശു അവനോടു പറഞ്ഞത് : നീ പുതുതായി ജനിക്കണം, എന്നത്രെ (യോഹ. 3:3) പരീശന്മാർ മോശെയുടെ ന്യായപ്രമാണം പാലിക്കുന്നതിൽ അതീവ ശ്രദ്ധാലുക്കളായിരുന്നതുപോലെ മതപരമായ കാര്യങ്ങൾക്കുവേണ്ടി അവർ സമർപ്പിതരുമായിരുന്നു. പുതുതായി എന്നു ഭാഷാന്തരം ചെയ്തിരിക്കുന്ന വാക്കിന്, രണ്ടാമതൊരിക്കൽ, ഉയരത്തിൽ നിന്ന്, എന്നീ രണ്ടർത്ഥങ്ങൾ കൂടിയുണ്ട്. വീണ്ടും ജനനം എന്നു വിവരിക്കാവുന്ന പുതിയ ജനനം സമൂലമായ ഒരു പരിർത്തനമാണ്. ഉയരത്തിൽ നിന്നു ലഭ്യമാകുന്ന ഈ ജനനം ദൈവകൃപയും ദൈവശക്തിയുമാണ്. അതു മനുഷ്യപ്രയത്നം കൊണ്ടു സാധ്യമാകുന്നതല്ല. സമൂലമായ ഒരു പരിവർത്തനം തന്നിക്കാവശ്യമാണെന്ന് നിക്കോദെമോസ് തിരിച്ചറിഞ്ഞു. എന്നാൽ ഭൗതികമായി അമ്മയുടെ ഉദരത്തിൽ കടന്നു രണ്ടാമത് ജനിക്കുന്നതുപോലെ അസാധ്യമായ ഒരു സംഗതിയായിട്ടാണ് നിക്കോദെമോസ് പുതുജനനത്തെ വീക്ഷിച്ചത്. വീണ്ടും ജനനം പ്രാപിച്ച ഒരു വ്യക്തി ദൈവരാജ്യത്തിനു ഓഹരിക്കാരനാവുകയാണ് (3:3, 5) വരാനിരിക്കുന്ന ഒരു ജീവിതമാത്രമല്ല ദൈവരാജ്യം. ഈ ലോകത്തിൽ ദൈവമക്കൾ ദൈവാധിപത്യത്തിലായി തീരുമ്പോൾ ദൈവരാജ്യം അവരിൽ വന്നുകഴിയും. വീണ്ടും ജനനം പ്രാപിച്ച ഒരു വ്യക്തി ദൈവഹിതത്തിനു പൂർണ്ണമായി വിധേയപ്പെട്ടു ജീവിക്കും. സ്വശക്തിയാൽ ഒരു മനുഷ്യനും ഇതു സാധ്യമല്ല. എന്നാൽ മനുഷ്യന്റെ പ്രതികരണം ദൈവശക്തി ലഭിക്കുന്നതിനു മുഖാന്തിരമാണ്. യേശു പറഞ്ഞു, വെള്ളത്താലും ആത്മാവിനാലും

ജനിച്ചില്ല എങ്കിൽ ദൈവരാജ്യത്തിൽ കടക്കുവാൻ ആർക്കും കഴിയുകയില്ല (യോഹ. 3:15). വെള്ളം ശുദ്ധീകരണത്തെയും ദൈവവചനത്തെയും കുറിക്കുന്നു. അതിനാൽ ദൈവവചനം അനുസരിക്കണം. ആത്മാവ് ശക്തിയാണ്. ദൈവം നമ്മെ രക്ഷിക്കുകയും തന്റെ സ്വന്തമായി നമ്മെ സ്വീകരിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യുമ്പോൾ ഇതുവരെ നാം അനുഭവിച്ചിട്ടില്ലാത്ത ദൈവകൃപയാൽ അവൻ നമ്മെ നിറയ്ക്കും. അതുകൊണ്ടാണ് വി. പൗലോസ് രേഖപ്പെടുത്തുന്നത് : ഒരുത്തൻ ക്രിസ്തുവിലായാൽ അവൻ പുതിയ സൃഷ്ടി ആകുന്നു; പഴയത് കവിഞ്ഞുപോയി, ഇതാ, അതു പുതുതായി തീർന്നിരിക്കുന്നു (2 കൊരി. 5:17)

വീണ്ടും ജനനം തീവ്രമായ ഒരു പ്രായോഗിക അനുഭവമാകണം. ദൈവം എപ്രകാരം പ്രവർത്തിക്കുന്നു എന്നു പൂർണ്ണമായി നമുക്കു മനസ്സിലാക്കുവാൻ കഴികയില്ലെങ്കിലും അതിന്റെ ഫലം സുഗ്രഹമാണ്. കാറ്റിനെ നാം കാണുന്നില്ല, എന്നിരുന്നാലും അതിന്റെ സാന്നിധ്യം നമുക്കു കാണുവാനും അനുഭവിക്കുവാനും കഴിയും എന്നതുപോലെയാണ് ആത്മാവിന്റെ പ്രവർത്തനവും.

ദൈവം നമ്മെ രക്ഷിച്ചതിനായി ദൈവത്തിന് സ്തോത്രം ചെയ്യാം. രക്ഷയുടെ ഫലം നമ്മുടെ ജീവിതത്തിൽ കൂടുതൽ കൂടുതൽ തെളിയിച്ചു കാട്ടുവാൻ ദൈവം നമ്മെ സഹായിക്കുന്നതിനുവേണ്ടി പ്രാർത്ഥിക്കാം.

ദൈവം നമ്മെ അനുഗ്രഹിക്കട്ടെ.

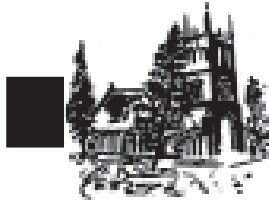
**CSI MKD Bicentenary Celebrations**

We require around Rs.20.00 lakhs for the two projects.

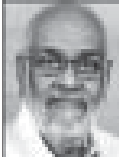

“Heavenly Father, we come before you today to ask your forgiveness and to seek your direction and guidance. We know Your Word says: “Woe to those who call evil good”, but that is exactly what we have done.

- We have lost our spiritual equilibrium and reversed our values.
- We have ridiculed the absolute truth of Your Word and called it Pluralism.
- We have worshipped other gods and called it multiculturalism.
- We have endorsed perversion and called it alternative lifestyle.
- We have exploited the poor and called it the lottery.
- We have rewarded laziness and called it welfare.
- We have killed our unborn and called it choice.
- We have shot pro-abortionists and called it justifiable.
- We have neglected to discipline our children and called it building self-esteem.
- We have abused power and called it politics.
- We have embezzled public funds and called it essential expenses.
- We have institutionalised bribery and called it sweets of office.
- We have coveted our neighbour’s possessions and called it upward mobility.
- We have polluted the air with profanity and pornography and called it freedom of expression.
- We have ridiculed the time-honoured values of our forefathers and called it enlightenment. Search us, Oh GOD, and know our hearts today; cleanse us from every sin and set us free. Amen!”

The response was immediate. A number of legislators walked out during the prayer in protest.

But within six weeks, Central Christian Church, where Rev. Wright is pastor, logged more than 5,000 phone calls and only 47 of those calls responded negatively.

With the LORD’S help, may this prayer sweep over our nations and WHOLEHEARTEDLY let it become our desire that we are called ‘ONE WORLD FOR GOD’

## **GROWING UP IN THE CHRISTIAN FAITH**

Watching a magic show this past week made me think how easy it would be if all our problems could disappear this way. If only with the twist of a wand or a magic spell we could gain our wishes and spell all our problems away !

But then life doesn't work that way. Each day we have to face our problems and wake up the next morning expecting more. Till now in my life I have not met a single person who is 100% content in their lives. There was always something left to be hoped for. The freedom to live, money, power, wealth, happiness, etc.: aren't these the things that we all strive for?

### **So where does Christian faith come in?**

In this present day of living, there is not a single moment to spend for oneself. The web of education, career, families, and employment is woven around us so tight that at times sparing even 5 minutes for reading the Bible seems like a herculean task. ## YOUTH WITH CHRIST IN ACTION

Daniel 1:1-17 || Psalm 98 || Acts 6:1-7 || John 1:35-42

“Must I go, and empty-handed, thus my dear Redeemer meet?  
Not one day of service give Him, Lay no trophy at His feet?”

Charles Carroll Luther was a journalist and lay evangelist before being ordained as a Baptist minister in 1886. Though not a prolific composer, he authored this hymn in 1877 when he heard a Rev. A.G. Upham relate the story of a young man who was about to die. This young man had been a Christian for only one month. Though thankful to the Lord for granting him salvation during his final hour, he was nevertheless grieved that he'd had no opportunity to serve the Lord nor to share Him with others. He explained, “I am not afraid to die; Jesus saves me now. But must I go empty handed?” Does this question challenge us to be in action with Christ?

In John 1:35-42, we see a pattern of Kingdom advancing, or how Glory of Christ paves the way for advancing the Kingdom. The first step is of **seeking Christ**. When John the Baptist said “Behold the Lamb of God”, from that moment onwards the disciples followed Christ. The disciples Andrew and the other one, truly needed Him, and their response was of genuine seekers. As Jeremiah 29:13 says “you will seek Me and find Me, when you seek Me with all your heart”. We are fortunate to know the Words of wisdom, the heavenly Manna, the eternal God through the Scriptures and yet we embrace the truths from an arm's length, when the Words of Light talk about the necessity of one's heart being near to its Maker. The heart seeks the treasures laid on the grave roads of this world and to this generation, that hardly finds the need for Grace and is pleasure seeking and sin laden by choice; Jesus asks “What do you seek?” (John 1:38). Sadly, to the church, its ministries, the worship services, the social programs, the celebrations and the outreaches, this same question resonates - What do they seek? What do you need? Is it a matter of fantasy or because of the family heritage we seek to uphold or is it for success and for solution to our problems, that we seek Christ? Men seek to know the news updates, the trailers of new films, the political situations of states, the scandals of stars; yet the sight of Christ doesn't captivate their attention.

With seeking Christ, comes the exciting journey of **following Christ**. Christ knew what the disciples needed and His invitation was to Come and See (Vs 39). When Nicodemus came to see Christ at night, he was given the invitation to have a new way of Life, by being born again; when the Samaritan woman encountered Christ at the well, it was an invitation for a new way of worship. Following Christ unlocks the spiritual realities and the ultimate meaning of life. This is the glory of following the Son of God and the Grace we receive is the **dwelling Christ**. We see the whole meaning of dwelling in John 14:23, when Jesus says “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him”. As we dwell with Christ, we are transformed into a new creation with new hope, new purposes and new way of living.

This new life is taught and promised throughout the scriptures. In the book of Daniel 1: 1-17, Daniel and his friends were taken captive to a foreign land and were taught their culture and law. But Daniel had already known the Lord of Israel and His laws. So he and his friends chose not to defile themselves by eating the royal food as it might have been sacrificed meat or what the Levitical law called “unclean”. The life of Daniel was eventful as it faced the tests and temptations, but we see him walking with the Lord

In the New Testament also, in the lives of men who chose to follow Christ and walk with Him, we see the product of this new life, being in **action with Christ**; an example of which we see in Acts 6:1-7. Here the early church leaders faced two problems - one, the Hellenistic widows being neglected in daily food distribution and two, the question of whether the apostles should give up teaching and take up this ministry of mercy. The solution was to appoint seven men of good repute and filled with the Holy Ghost. They were neither from Jewish background, nor of the present leadership but the widows were cared for and the apostles could continue preaching the Word. The whole church agreed to the solution and the church again increased in size. There was no neutral living for this church. Though the early church faced problems and persecutions, they were a crowd who had seen the Glory of God, followed their Master’s way and they set out to disturb the normalities and principalities of this world. We see the result of this new life in Stephen and Philip. Stephen whom God called

from a Greek background, witnessed to the Jewish council and to Saul of Tarsus. Philip later took the gospel to neighbouring nations. To the early church and to us, our good Lord has given the directions to lead this new life through the way of prayer and promises laid down in Scriptures (John 16:33).

Being a partaker in Christ needs the heart that truly seeks Him, the desire to study and know the truths of His Words, the passion to follow the way of faith and the courage to live a life worthy of His calling.

To all who thus labour, Christ offers rest: “Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest, Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls” ( Math 11:28,29). Such receivers of Grace could sing a new song because of what Christ has done for them. Psalm 98:4-8 talks about the joy of the redeemed righteous worshippers who are truly worshipping the God of the universe and their lives shout forth His praise. “Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth; break forth into joyous song and sing praises!”

So Church of Christ, is your life a joyous journey to witness to the glorious Redeemer? Has your life seen the practicalities of witnessing to the power of Christ? Does the Light that shone in your darkness call you to share this new light to the society?

“O ye saints, arouse, be earnest, Up and work while yet 'tis day;

Ere the night of death o'er take thee, Strive for souls while still you may.”

Let us heed this hymn's counsel, to stop wasting our years in sin, and instead to give those to our Saviour and to strive for the salvation of souls while we still have breath. May we pray to be spiritually energized to take up the burden of sharing the gospel, so that rather than living a life of vanity to be later regretted, we may redeem our time (Eph. 5:16) and bear fruit unto eternal life (John 4:36).
