Vicar's Reflections

Dearly Beloved,

Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

In this letter I would like to pen down some thoughts related to the importance of the Word of God.

If the Word of God is important in our life, then reading and studying the Bible should be a regular part of our daily living. The psalmist tells us that God's Word is like water to a tree (Ps. 1:3). Without water the tree would wither and die. Without God's Word man is equally lifeless.

The contrast between the man of God and the man of the world is vividly brought out in Psalm 1:4: "The wicked are like chaff which the wind drives away". This is an apt picture of many people in our modern world. They have no foundation on which to build their lives. They have no standards outside themselves with the result that they have no clear distinction between right and wrong. They are unstable and liable to be driven away by the slightest wind of adversity. They talk spacioously of being free, of not being under bondage to any system of rules, but their freedom is like the freedom of the chaff. Chaff is free in a way that a tree is not, but it is lifeless and useless.

Blessing does not come from denying all standards and scoffing at those who do have solid standards, (Ps. 1:1) but in a life which is firmly anchored in the "Law of the Lord", (Ps. 1:2) when the psalmist speaks of meditating on the law day and night, he means that the Word of God should be so familiar to us that we automatically refer all our thoughts and actions to it. If we are tempted to do something that is contrary to God's standards, at once our knowledge of the Word checks us. This can only be so if we are constantly reading and studying our Bible.

Moreover there will always be need for further growth. The Scriptures contain everything necessary "that the man of God may be complete." (2 Tim 3:17). They are valuable for reproof and correction (2 Tim 3:16). They are valuable also for "teaching" and "training" in righteousness. We must be ready to accept the corrections of the Word if we are to

be built up by the Word. The Word corrects in order to train in righteousness. It trains in righteousness in order to equip us for every good work. Our study of the Scriptures should lead to more effective service for God and for other people.

Let us thank God for His Word. Let us pray that the Lord may work still more deeply in our hearts.

May God bless you all.

യേശുക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ നിസ്തുല്യനാമത്തിൽ സ്നേഹവന്ദനം.

ദൈവവചനത്തിന്റെ പ്രാധാന്യത്തെക്കുറിച്ച് ഈ കത്തിലൂടെ ചില സംഗതികൾ കുറിക്കാമെന്നാഗ്രഹിക്കുന്നു. ദൈവവചനം നമ്മുടെ ജീവിതത്തിൽ പ്രധാനപ്പെട്ടതാണെങ്കിൽ ദൈവനംദിന ജീവിതത്തിൽ ക്രമീകൃതമായി ബൈബിൾ വായിക്കുകയും പാലിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യും. ഒരു വൃക്ഷത്തിനു വെള്ളം പോലെയാണ് മനുഷ്യന് ദൈവത്തിന്റെ വചനമെന്ന് സങ്കീർത്തനക്കാരൻ പറയുന്നു (സങ്കീ. 1:3). വെള്ളമില്ലെങ്കിൽ വൃക്ഷം വാടിക്കരിഞ്ഞുപോകും. ദൈവ വചനമില്ലെങ്കിൽ മനുഷ്യനും അതുപോലെ ജീവനില്ലാതായിത്തീരും.

സങ്കീ. 1:4-ൽ ലോകമനുഷ്യനും ദൈവമനുഷ്യനും തമ്മിലുള്ള അന്തരം വ്യക്തമാണ്. ദുഷ്ടൻ കാറ്റുപാറ്റുന്ന പതിർ പോലെയാണ്. ആധുനിക കാലഘട്ടത്തിലെ അനേകമാളുകളെ സംബന്ധിച്ചും ഇത് യാഥാർത്ഥ്യമാണ്. അവർക്കു വേരില്ല. അവരുടെ ജീവിതത്തിന് അടിസ്ഥാനമില്ല. അവരിൽ തന്നെയും, പുറത്തും അവർക്കു ആദർശങ്ങളില്ല, അതിന്റെ ഫലമായി ശരിയും തെറ്റും തമ്മിൽ തിരിച്ചറിയുവാൻ അവർക്ക് കഴിവില്ല. സ്ഥിരതയില്ലാത്തതിനാൽ പ്രതികൂല കാറ്റു വീശുമ്പോൾ അവർ പാറിപ്പോകും. തങ്ങൾ സ്വതന്ത്രരാണെന്നും, നിയമങ്ങൾക്കോ, വ്യവസ്ഥകൾക്കോ തങ്ങൾ അടിമകളല്ലെന്നും അവർ പറയും, എന്നാൽ പതിരിന്റെ സ്വാതന്ത്ര്യമാണ് അവരുടേത്. ഒരു വൃക്ഷം സ്വതന്ത്രമല്ല, അർത്ഥത്തിൽ പതിർ സ്വതന്ത്രമാണ്, കാരണം അതു പ്രയോജനരഹിതവും ജീവനില്ലാത്തതുമാണ്.

ഉറപ്പുള്ള ജീവിതദർശനങ്ങളെ പരിഹസിക്കുന്നതും എല്ലാ ആദർശങ്ങളേയും പരിത്യജിക്കുന്നതുമല്ല അനുഗ്രഹം, മറിച്ച് ദൈവവചനത്തിൽ അടിസ്ഥാനപ്പെട്ട ജീവിതങ്ങളാണ് അനുഗ്രഹിക്കപ്പെടുന്നത് (സങ്കീ. 1:2). ദൈവത്തിന്റെ ന്യായപ്രമാണം രാപ്പകൽ ധ്യാനിക്കുമെന്ന് സങ്കീർത്തനക്കാരൻ പറയുമ്പോൾ അർത്ഥമാക്കുന്നത് ദൈവവചനം നമുക്കു സുപരിചിതവും നമ്മുടെ ചിന്തകളും പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളും സ്വഭാവികമായും അതിനനുസരിച്ചാകുമെന്നാണ്. ദൈവവചനത്തിനു വിരുദ്ധമായി എന്തെങ്കിലും പ്രവർത്തിക്കുവാൻ പ്രേരണയുണ്ടാകുമ്പോൾ ആ നിമിഷം ദൈവവചനപരിജ്ഞാനം നമ്മെ അതിൽ നിന്നു പിന്തിരിപ്പിക്കും. ബൈബിൾ ക്രമമായി പഠിക്കുകയും ധ്യാനിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യുന്നവനു മാത്രമേ ഇത്തരം അനുഭവം ഉണ്ടാകയുള്ളൂ.

ഇതു കൂടാതെ തിരുവചനത്തിലുള്ള വളർച്ച ഒരുവന് അനിവാര്യമാണ്. ദൈവമനുഷ്യനെ പൂർണ്ണനാക്കുന്നതിനുള്ള സകലതും ദൈവവചനത്തിൽ അടങ്ങിയിട്ടുണ്ട് (2 തീമോ. 3:17). ഗുണീകരണത്തിനും ശാസനത്തിനും ദൈവവചനം പ്രധാനമാണ് (2 തീമോ. 3:16). അതുപോലെ ദൈവവചനം ഉപദേശത്തിനും നീതിയിലെ അഭ്യസനത്തിനും പ്രയോജനമുള്ളതാണ്. വചനത്തിലാണ് നാം പണിയപ്പെടുന്നതെങ്കിൽ വചനത്താലുള്ള തിരുത്തപ്പെടലുകൾ സ്വീകരിക്കുവാൻ നാം തയ്യാറാകും. നീതിയിലെ അഭ്യസനത്തിനായി വചനം നമ്മെ തിരുത്തും. എല്ലാ നല്ല പ്രവർത്തിയും ചെയ്യുന്നതിന് നീതിയിലെ അഭ്യസനം നമ്മെ സജ്ജമാക്കും.

ദൈവത്തിനും മനുഷ്യർക്കും ഫലപ്രദമായി കൂടുതൽ ശുശ്രൂഷകൾ നിർവ്വഹിക്കുവാൻ തിരുവചനപഠനം നമ്മെ സഹായിക്കട്ടെ. ദൈവവചനത്തിനായി ദൈവത്തെ സ്തുതിക്കാം. നമ്മുടെ ഹൃദയങ്ങളിൽ വചനം ആഴമായി പ്രവർത്തിക്കേണ്ടതിന് ദൈവത്തോടു പ്രാർത്ഥിക്കാം.

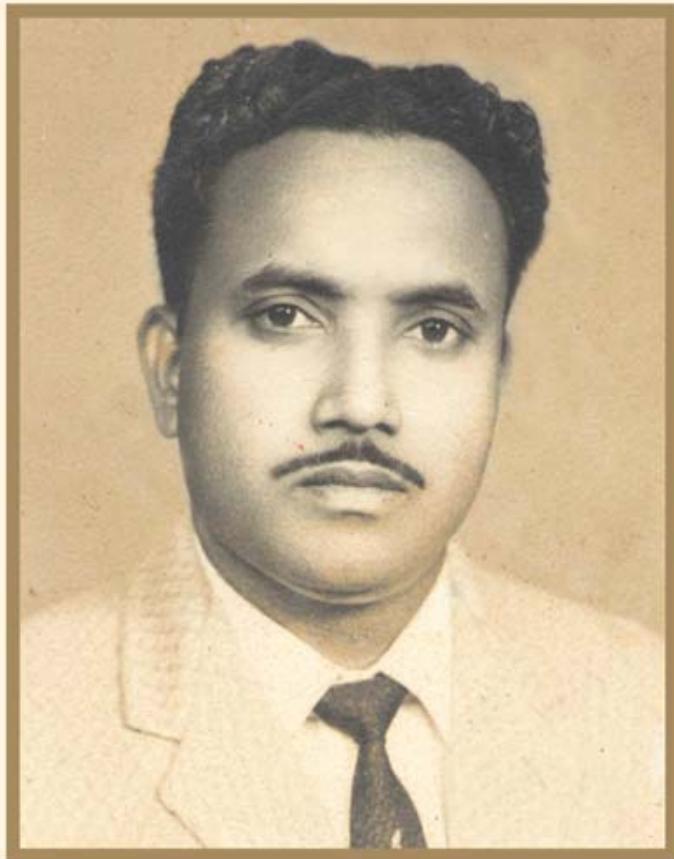






PEOPLE OF GOD AMBASSADORS OF CHRIST

‘People’(usually functioning as plural) is widely used in common parlance to mean persons collectively or in general, living together in a country sharing the same nationality; one’s family; persons loyal to someone powerful. (Ref. Collins’ English Dictionary).

But here the word takes a special dimension, a spiritual one, because the word used is PEOPLE-OF-GOD - children of God, i.e. sons and daughters of God!

Who is a child of God? How does one become a child of God? A famous evangelist once remarked, “God doesn’t have grandchildren”. Yes, God gives the power/right for persons to become members of His family. Of course, conditions apply!

“But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become sons of God, even to them that believe on His name; Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, not of the will of man, but of God” Jn. 1: 12-13. (*Underlined for emphasis*)

“For as many as are lead by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.” Rom. 8:14

Have I received Christ as my personal saviour, as the Lord and Master of my life? Do I believe in His agape love that leads Him to the cross of Calvary to suffer and die as propitiation for my sins? That He overcame death and ascended to His throne by His Father’s side interceding for me? Am I lead by the Spirit of God? If only my answers are in the affirmative, I belong to His family.

If I am God’s family, I am entitled to enjoy all the rights and privileges accorded to them. Let us look at the rights and privileges on offer:

In 2 Cor. 6: 16 - 19 it is written, “....for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, *and they shall be my people.*”

..... And (I) will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.”

1 Pet. 2: 9, “But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that you should shew forth the praise of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.”

Rom.8:15-17, “ ... ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

“The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

“And if children, then heirs of God, and joint heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with *him*, that we may be also glorified together.”

What glorious inheritance God’s people have!

While they enjoy their sonship, they are duty bound to ‘*show forth the praise of Him who called*’ them.

No privileges come without responsibilities.

The wonderful experience of having been born into God’s family emboldens God’s children to undertake His mission.

What does God expect of His people? “Now then we are ambassadors for Christ...” 2 Cor. 5:20.

To become ambassadors for Christ is among the most important missions for people of God – self-appointed Ambassadors!

Dictionary definition of an ambassador: “diplomatic minister of the highest rank accredited as permanent representative to another country or sovereign”.

As his country’s emissary he protects the interests of his country; be spokesperson on his county’s behalf; be promoter of trade and commerce; defender if and when the need arises.

God’s people, as ambassadors of the Triune God, promote the interests of the Son who has empowered them to be in His service. Since the mission entrusted to God’s family is multi-faceted, they are “ambassadors-at-Large”, with special duties.

1. First and foremost, a child of God lives and works to GLORIFY God.

“Our Father in heaven, May your name be glorified!” The Lord’s Prayer begins thus.

“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven” Mat. 5:16

Does my light shine before men and bring honour and glory to Christ? Do I glorify Him in my thoughts, words and actions?

2. God's children as ambassadors are commissioned to be His WITNESSES.

"But ye shall receive power after that the Holy Ghost has come upon you and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria and unto the uttermost parts of the earth." Acts 1: 8

Witnesses in Jerusalem to begin with! My Jerusalem is my own people. Are there members among my family who have not 'received' Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour? Who do not yet 'believe' in His atoning sacrifice for them? Who do not accept the abiding presence of the Living Christ in their lives? Let me be Christ's witness for them.

Then on to the neighbouring Judea where He is still being rejected!

Samaria is holding on to bits and pieces of misinformation of the saving grace of Christ the Messiah.

Then the nations of the world who hunger and thirst for the Gospel – now more than ever! The gospel has never been more relevant. The world has never been more ready. Fulfillment of the Great Commission of our Lord (Ref. Mat.28:18-20; Mark 16:15) is very much the need of the hour! - Making disciples under His authority and abiding presence!
