Selected from one of the best books of meditations written by Dr Stanley Jones entitled **IN CHRIST**.

The phrase "In Christ" or its equivalent is found 172 times in the New Testament. St Paul the greatest interpreter of Christianity, saw that this was the ultimate phrase, dividing all humanity into two classes "In Christ" and "Out of Christ"

Those in Christ have eternal life, those out of Christ have eternal death. This is the ultimate division that divides. In Christ there is no other division like Jew and Gentile, Greek and Barbarian, bond and free, man and woman.

All are one new creation in Christ.

JESUS CHRIST IS THE KING OF PEACE

Prior to His departure, Jesus uttered these words to His disciples, "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid"

(John 14: 27 NIV).

The above verse tells us the idea of Peace of God. However, for the world the idea of peace is different from the peace the King of Peace promised. If violence can be removed from this world and every nation in this world wholeheartedly aspire and achieve a peaceful society, we do not need the United Nations and we need not measure Global Peace Index; such society then will become livable with freedom and happiness. But the reality is the more the nations try the less the peace among world nations.

Global Peace Index (GPI) measures the relative position of nations' and regions' peacefulness. In the past decade, the GPI has presented trends of increased global violence and less peacefulness. The present situation continues to be the same.

Long-term findings of the 2017 GPI include a less peaceful world over the past decade, a 2.14 per cent deterioration in the global level of peace in the past decade, growing inequality in peace between the most and least peaceful countries, a long-term reduction in the GPI Militarization domain, and a widening impact of terrorism, with historically high numbers of people killed in terrorist incidents over the past 10 years.

Many religions believe in world peace. The United Nations were created to make world peace. Many theorists, however, believe that humans were born to be violent and preventing it would not be possible because it is in their nature.

In the Book of Genesis two brothers Cain and Abel the first two sons of Adam and Eve are mentioned. Cain, the firstborn, was a farmer, and his brother Abel was a shepherd. The brothers made sacrifices to God, each of his own produce, but God favored Abel's sacrifice instead of Cain's. This infuriated Cain and he killed his brother, and this is the genesis of first violence. When confronted by God, Cain had the audacity to tell God "How should I know? Am I his baby sitter (Genesis 4: 9 Message). The world has not changed since then one bit.

Now if we read Genesis 6, we read that 'The Lord saw how great the wickedness of the human race had become on the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of the human heart was only evil all the time. The Lord regretted that he had made human beings on the earth, and his heart was deeply troubled.

This situation has not changed and we continue to live in a violent world. To save the violent world God sent His son Jesus Christ as the Prince of Peace. In **Isaiah** we read "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." **John 3: 16** we read "God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life."

In a world full of war and violence, it's difficult to see how Jesus could be the all-powerful God who acts in human history and be the embodiment of peace. But physical safety and political harmony don't necessarily reflect the kind of peace He's talking about (John 14:27).

In our sinful state, we are enemies with God (Romans 5:10). "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). Because of Christ's sacrifice, we are restored to a relationship of peace with God (Romans 5:1). This is the deep, abiding peace between our hearts and our Creator that cannot be taken away (John 10:27,28) and the ultimate fulfillment of Christ's work as "Prince of Peace."

Knowing that Jesus Christ is not only the Prince and Ruler of Peace but also the King of Peace gives us the confidence under any circumstances that we do not have to fear the present and the future. He gives His peace to those who accept it as a result of the Holy Spirit working in their lives. Jesus Christ, who is the King of Peace, does not give us the same peace that this world gives., the peace that God gives us is the state of being confident in knowing that He is in full control.

In John 12: 12-16, we read the account of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem riding on a donkey's colt and a multitude of people came out to meet Him spreading palm branches while shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! The King of Israel!".

This event is the fulfillment of the first coming of Jesus as prophesied in **Zechariah 9:9**. And if we continue to read **Zechariah 9:10**, **11**, we read about the prophecy on Jesus' second coming which is yet to come.

In Scriptures among other Scriptures, we could see

clearly the attributes given to Jesus as not only the "King of Righteousness" but also the "King of Peace."

The King of Peace has the authority to pardon or forgive us from our sins (Mat 9:6). To emphasize authority of the son of God, Jesus forgives and heals a paralyzed man that was brought to Him, He said to the man, "Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven." It could have been easier for Jesus to say, "Get up, take your mat and go home." But He did this to make known to them that the Son of Man has authority on earth to pardon sins (v.6) and He does pardon our sins!.

Several passages are there in New Testament where we see Jesus Christ healing the lame man by pardoning his sins. Sickness, however, is part of life in this fallen world as a result of our collective rebellion against God. Whether sin is associated or not with the sickness of men, one thing is for sure; and that is Jesus our King of Peace has been given the authority to forgive our sins.

The nature of God is to forgive. God made numerous prophecies that a Messiah would come into the world. If people believed those prophecies, they were saved by grace through faith. They looked forward in faith to the Messiah coming as we look back in faith that He came. Old and New Testament believers are both saved by looking to Christ in faith, but from opposite sides of the cross. People in the Old Testament were saved by believing Jesus would come, like we're saved by believing Jesus came.

The King of Peace enriches our lives, (2 Cor 8:9) and He abides in us during trials - the King of Peace neither abandon us or leaves His people (Heb 13: 5), He comforts us in troubles - The King of Peace is our comfort and our resting place (2 Cor 1: 3 - 4). He ensures us His Love - The King of Peace gives us divine assurance of His everlasting love (John 15:13). We are also secure in the love of God because we have become an heir and legitimate son to our heavenly Father (Romans 8: 17).

To sum it up, Jesus Christ the King of Peace:

- P ardons our sins
- E nriches our lives
- A bides in us in trials
- C omforts us in troubles
- **E** nsures us His love (adopted from *Jess Cortez*)

Tail Peace: We are being warned that the patience of God will not continue forever as we see in the present CORONA VIRUS attacking every country in this earth God created and cherished.

A UNIQUE WALK

They compelled a passer-by, Simeon the Cyrene, who was coming in from the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to carry HIS cross.

Mark 15.21

Simeon was only a passer-by. He was not a local resident of Judea. He was a visitor to Jerusalem, where the crucifixion was taking place. May be Simeon came there to celebrate the pass-over. He just happened to be there, as Jesus was walking through roads of Jerusalem carrying His cross, having fallen multiple times. That cross was too heavy for Jesus and He was totally tired. One of the soldiers looked around, saw this stout man and compelled him to carry the cross. It was not Simeon's choice, but a responsibility that was thrust upon him. The word used in the Gospels is Simon was 'compelled'. While doing this work which was forced on him, he got this very rare chance, 'to walk with JESUS, the Son of God, to accompany Him in the last hours of HIS last day on earth

Simeon carried the cross, walking in step with Jesus, an extremely different opportunity which even none of the disciples could get. He heard the condemning words of the soldiers. He witnessed the heavy breathing of Jesus, and must have been shocked at the violent beating of the hard-hearted soldiers as they lashed on the back of Jesus. He saw the drops of blood falling down from the body of Jesus. As he saw all this, he would have been equally wonderstruck at the silent, calm and poised disposition of Jesus. This was his first encounter with HIM, possible he may not have even heard of Him before? Jesus' silent

endurance of everything, even the despising looks from the crowd may have made Simon wonder, 'What a marvellous young man?' No bitter words from His mouth as a response to the physical and mental agony He was going through! With an aching and a torn body, Jesus was bearing everything. Simeon never understood why they were treating Him like this. But he carried through, walked with, and finally must have waited long at the foot of the cross, compelled in his heart, to see what happens. That forced duty, may be a responsibility which he resented at the start brought a blessing in his life.

That walk together with Jesus, a burdensome walk, may be even an embarrassing walk, brought a radical change in him. He returned home as a changed man. Through him, his family came to know Jesus. His son, Rufus is referred to as, 'the chosen in the Lord', (Rom16.13). Simon and his children became leaders in the early church. Through Simeon gospel began to spread beyond Judea, even to Africa.

An accidental encounter and a compelled responsibility turned to be a life changing experience, resulting in transformed lives.

Jesus calls us, "Come, take up your cross and follow Me".

Just a closer walk with Thee Grant it Jesus, if you please, Daily walking close to Thee Let it be dear Lord, Let it be.
