'കർത്താവിനോടുള്ള ഭക്തി തന്നെ ജ്ഞാനം, ദോഷം അകന്നു നടക്കുന്നതു തന്നെ വിവേകം'. ഇയ്യോബ് 28: 28. സദ്യശ്യവാക്യങ്ങൾ 2: 6ൽ ശലോമോൻ രാജാവ് ജ്ഞാനത്തെക്കുറിച്ചു പറയുന്നത്, 'യഹോവയല്ലോ ജ്ഞാനം നൽകുന്നത്; അവന്റെ വായിൽ നിന്ന് പരിജ്ഞാനവും വിവേകവും വരുന്നു'. യഥാർത്ഥ ജ്ഞാനം ദൈവം തന്നെയാകുന്നു. അതിനാൽ ദൈവത്തിൽ നിന്ന് പഠിക്കണം. യേശു പറയുന്നു, 'ആകയാൽ എന്റെ നുകം ഏറ്റുകൊണ്ട് എന്നോട് പഠിപ്പിൻ എന്ന്. പഠിതാക്കൾ കേൾക്കുന്നവരും ചെയ്യുന്നവരും ആയിരിക്കണം. സത്യത്തിനു വേണ്ടി അവസാനിക്കാത്ത അന്വേഷണമാണ് വിദ്യാഭ്യാസം. യേശു ആകുന്നു സത്യം. അതിനാൽ അവനിൽനിന്നും നമുക്ക് തുടർന്നും പഠിക്കാം; അവനാണ് യഥാർത്ഥ ജ്ഞാനം; അവനിൽ നിന്ന് പഠിച്ച് നിത്യത അവകാശമാക്കുവാൻ അവൻ നമ്മെ ക്ഷണിക്കുന്നു.

രണ്ടാമത്, ഭൂമിയിലെ ജീവൻ സംബന്ധിച്ച് പരിസ്ഥിതി ശാസ്ത്രം ആശങ്കകൾ ഉയർത്തുന്നു. സൃഷ്ടി ദൈവത്തെയും ദൈവവചനത്തെയും അനുസരിക്കുമ്പോൾ ജീവൻ ഉണ്ടാകുന്നു. പരിസ്ഥിതി ശാസ്ത്രത്തിന്റെ ഒന്നാമത്തെ നിയമം പ്രകൃതിയിലുള്ള സകലതും മറ്റെല്ലാമുമായി ബന്ധപ്പെട്ടിരിക്കുന്നു എന്നതാണ്. പ്രകൃതിയോടുള്ള അക്രമം മനുഷ്യരോടുള്ള അക്രമത്തിലേക്ക് നയിക്കുന്നു. എത്രമാത്രം നാം പ്രകൃതിയെ ശല്യപ്പെടുത്തുമോ അത്രമാത്രം നമ്മെ ശല്യപ്പെടുത്തുകയാണ്. നാശത്തിൽ നിന്നും പ്രകൃതിയെ സംരക്ഷിക്കുന്നതിനുള്ള ആത്യന്തിക ചുമതല

നമ്മുടേതാണ്.

പവിത്രമായിട്ടാണ് പരിസ്ഥിതി പരിഗണിക്കപ്പെടുന്നത്, അതിനാൽ പ്രകൃതിയോടുള്ള മനുഷ്യന്റെ ബന്ധവും പവിത്രമായിരിക്കണം. മനുഷ്യന്റെ അതിജീവനത്തിന് പ്രകൃതിയെ ആശ്രയിച്ചിരുന്നതിനാൽ കഴിഞ്ഞകാലത്ത്, ബഹുമാനത്തോടെയാണ് മനുഷ്യൻ പ്രകൃതിയെ കണ്ടിരുന്നത്. മനുഷ്യർക്ക് ദൈവം നൽകിയ ഔദാര്യ ദാനമാണ് പരിസ്ഥിതി, അതിനാൽ അതിനെ ബഹുമാനിക്കുന്നതിനും, കരുതുന്നതിനും, സംരക്ഷിക്കുന്നതിനും കഴിയണം. ഭൂമിയിൽ ജീവൻ നിലനിർത്തുന്ന പരിസ്ഥിതി ദൈവമഹത്വത്തെ വർണ്ണിക്കുന്നു. നമ്മുടെ പരിസ്ഥിതിക വിഷയം കേവലം സമ്മർദ്ദം ചെലുത്തുന്നതിനോ, പ്രതിഷേധം ഉയർത്തുന്നതിനോ ആയി പരിമിതപ്പെടുത്തരുത്, പ്രത്യുത, പ്രകൃതിയോടുള്ള നമ്മുടെ മനോഭാവത്തിന് മാറ്റമുണ്ടാകണം.

We Believe in the Triune God

Trinity Sunday

As I pen these thoughts just coming off the International Day of the Family on May 15th, I paid a visit to the United Nations Web page commentary on the topic of families - *"Families around the world are changing, many becoming smaller, as the number of single-parent households grows. The diminishing number of extended families and the increasing number of single-parent families put into sharp focus the issue of social protection"* – grim remarks from the world body. While we may think that the Indian situation is different, with Section 377 and the decriminalisation of adultery, the Indian idea of the family is changing too.

The 2020 COVID-19 pandemic brings into sharp focus the importance of investing in initiatives protecting the most vulnerable families. It is the families who bear the brunt of the crisis, sheltering their members from harm, caring for children and, at the same time, continuing their work responsibilities. Families are the hub of intergenerational interactions that support us in this crisis. Therefore teaching, edifying and investing in the nurture of the family is a worthwhile pursuit in the agenda of the church.

What is the relevance of the topic of family when we talk about our belief in the Triune God on Trinity Sunday? I want to give a practical slant to the reflection of Trinity Sunday through the familiar terrain of the family.

We start with the fact that the Trinity is the perfect model of the family - God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. There is no way of explaining the central Christian

teaching 'God is love' (I Jn. 4: 8) without the doctrine of Trinity. All the elements of love are present in 360 degrees of Trinity. The love of a nuclear family makes the family three and one at the same time - and that is best visible in the Trinity. This nature of the Trinity which is loving, mutually existing, showing compassionate solidarity, equality and freedom keeps our family life enduring. **The best mark of our belief in the Triune God is to live out this Trinitarian characteristic in our families.**

As we examine the Almanac for the Trinity Sunday and sequence the readings for the day, a few brilliant hues emerge from the scripture painting as far as the Family is concerned:

1. A picture of vibrant life, displaying the glory of God. The Old Testament passage Ezekiel 1:4~28 captures Ezekiel's vision of the glory of God. We see pictures of life, vibrancy and motion - signifying that the family could be a place of vibrant life, always in movement, God-ward - not a static, dull picture of modern life where for many a family, home is quite a drudgery and sometimes a painful experience. When the Unity in the Diversity of the Trinity is portrayed in our families, it is a pointer to the glory of God – while respecting and celebrating the uniqueness of each individual in the home, all of the diverse personalities come together to be united in essence and purpose, because of their connection to God. The prophetic vision challenges us to provide a vibrant, life-giving environment for our families in our homes – an environment that displays the glory of God.

2. **Family that practices righteousness** The Psalm appointed for the day, Psalm 98 is titled "Praising God who is righteous" Verse 2 says *The Lord has made his salvation known and revealed his righteousness to the nations.* Family as a place where righteousness of God is displayed - children will learn righteousness at the home of a family that practices righteousness. This righteousness is not based on human ability, but one that is experienced through Jesus. Glance through history - and there is enough evidence that a family that kneels before God plays a critical role in the creation of a righteous heritage.

3. **Grace, love and fellowship in the family** The New testament lesson in 2 Cor 13:11-14 points to the Benediction experience in the family. If children growing up are shaped by the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, love of God the Father and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit in the grind of daily life, we will have a generation which displays grace, love and fellowship in society - and we become the royal priesthood that declares the praises of Him who called us out of darkness into His eternal light. Our lives would speak of this.

4. **Discipleship in the family** The Gospel for the day is Mat 28:16-20 announcing the Great commission of making disciples. "*Go and make disciples...Teach them to obey everything I have commanded you.*" Family is the theatre or workshop of Christian discipleship. That's where (in the home) the law of the Lord is impressed upon the children's hearts. In Judeo-Christian tradition, the Father is the custodian of the sum total of all moral instruction. The baton of faith has to be transmitted to the next generation in the home, by the parents. That is the surest way

of making disciples. And in case, we think that is a daunting task, Jesus says *“And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”*

5. Room for mystery In the evening passage of Job 38:1-11 God responds to Job's questions saying - *“Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation? Tell me, if you understand. Who marked off its dimensions? Surely you know! Who stretched a measuring line across it?* In a world which is determined to find answers to everything, God reminds Job of the need to give room for mystery. Man always tries to relate in terms of human images, but God's wisdom and power are truly beyond human grasp. Many a home would be a better place if we acknowledge that there are things beyond the limits of human understanding and instead rely on God's wisdom and power.

6. Alignment in Purpose The final reading for the day is Matthew 11:25-30 which talks about the Father revealed in the Son - *All things have been committed to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.* How many times we have heard the expression, "Like Father-Like Son". God the Son carries out the mission which God the Father sent Him for. In them there is perfect alignment. How wonderful would it be if parents and children at the home / family are so aligned that their only mission is to carry out the will of the Father who sent them into this world. It is the picture of a rowing team, rowing in unison, and lunging forward to do God's will on earth. This is what pleases God.

As we wrap this up, when the 193 member states of the United Nations unanimously adopted the Sustainable Development Goals, they said families and family-oriented policies

and programmes are vital for the achievement of many of these goals.

The church has a significant role in equipping its families to live out the godly purpose in this world. What better time than the Trinity Sunday when we are reminded of the perfect Family that the Trinitarian family is! The command "*Be ye therefore perfect even as your Heavenly Father is perfect*", is the command to grow to the unity and solidarity of the Family hood of God. The command to become perfect is both personal and social as God Himself. If God is Love, He is Trinity. There is no uniqueness in Christian theology without the uniqueness and centrality of the doctrine of Trinity. It is the only all-inclusive teaching about God.

May the Trinitarian nature find expression in the families of our times! May our families be crucibles of love as we dream of making the world a better place, one family at a time!
