Vicar's Reflections

Beloved in Christ,

We begin the month of September with the choir Sunday. Hymns and Praises are indispensable in Christian worship. Saint Paul advises the church in Ephesus to “be filled with the Spirit as you sing Psalms and Hymns and Spiritual songs among yourselves, singing and making melody to the Lord in your hearts, giving thanks to God the Father at all times and for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ” (*Ephesians 5: 19,20*)

Why do we sing to the Lord? Because God is Holy. Holiness is the attribute of God. His name is Holy, His laws, His Commandments, His Service and everything He does is Holy (*Romans 7: 12*). His holiness is acknowledged in the praise of the Seraphim and the four living creatures in the heaven who never cease to sing “Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts” (*Isaiah 6: 2,3*). The Holy God says to His people “you shall be Holy for I the Lord your God am Holy” (*Leviticus 19: 2*). The promise that God made to His people in the beginning of Exodus “you shall be unto me a kingdom of priests and a Holy nation (*Exodus 19: 6*), declared at the end of the journey that they are the people for His own possession and He will set them high above all Nations that He has made in praise and in Fame and in Honour and that they shall be a people Holy to the Lord their God, provided that they should keep all his Commandments (*Deuteronomy 26: 18,19*).

In order to meet His approbation or enjoy His presence, the people of God were required to be Holy, separated from all defilements of the world and entirely consecrated to God.

The choir shares this holiness of God. Their seat, dress, everything shows the holiness. They are called, sanctified and dedicated to sing the glory of God. As He who called us is Holy, we must be holy in all our conduct, strive for peace with all men, without which no one will see the Lord.

A Christian must also be holy in order to be God's own possession. Holiness demands a distinct life to live in this world. Therefore, live as those who belong to Christ. This should become evident in our words and our deeds. May God bless our church choir and all its activities.

After a gap of 5 months, we are reopening our church, partially, for divine service. I take this opportunity to thank Lord God Almighty for allowing us to reopen the church. Please do join the divine worship thankfully and prayerfully, remembering the restraints we have to follow as trustworthy citizens of our country.

കർത്താവിൽ പ്രിയരേ,
 ഗായകസംഘ ഞായറാഴ്ചയോടു കൂടെയാണ് സെപ്റ്റംബർ മാസം നാം ആരംഭിക്കുന്നത്. ക്രിസ്തീയ ആരാധനയിൽ കീർത്തനങ്ങൾക്കും സ്തുതികൾക്കും അതുല്യമായ ഒരു സ്ഥാനമുണ്ട്. എഫെസോസ് സഭയെ പഠലോസ് ഉപദേശിക്കുന്നത് ഇപ്രകാരമാണ്, "ആത്മാവു നിറഞ്ഞവരായി സങ്കീർത്തനങ്ങളാലും സ്തുതികളാലും ആത്മീകഗീതങ്ങളാലും തമ്മിൽ സംസാരിച്ചും നിങ്ങളുടെ ഹൃദയത്തിൽ കർത്താവിനു പാടിയും കീർത്തനം ചെയ്തും നമ്മുടെ കർത്താവായ യേശുക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ നാമത്തിൽ ദൈവവും പിതാവും മായവന് എല്ലായ്പ്പോഴും എല്ലാറ്റിനും വേണ്ടിയും സ്തോത്രം ചെയ്യുകൊൾവിൻ" **(എഫെസ്യർ 5:19, 20)**

എന്തുകൊണ്ട് കർത്താവിനു പാടണം? ദൈവം വിശുദ്ധനായതുകൊണ്ട് ദൈവത്തെ സ്തുതിക്കണം. ദൈവത്തിന്റെ സ്വഭാവമാണ് വിശുദ്ധി. വിശുദ്ധി എന്നാകുന്നു അവന്റെ നാമം, അവന്റെ കൽപ്പനകളും ന്യായപ്രമാണവും അവന്റെ ശുശ്രൂഷയും വിശുദ്ധമാണ്; അവൻ ചെയ്യുന്നതെല്ലാം വിശുദ്ധം തന്നെ. **(റോമർ 7:12)** സെറാഫീമിന്റെ സ്തുതിയിൽ ദൈവത്തിന്റെ പരിശുദ്ധി അംഗീകരിക്കുകയാണ്. അതുപോലെ സ്വർഗ്ഗത്തിലെ നാലു ജീവികളും ഇടതടവില്ലാതെ പാടുകയാണ് 'സൈന്യങ്ങളുടെ യഹോവ പരിശുദ്ധൻ, പരിശുദ്ധൻ, പരിശുദ്ധൻ' എന്ന് **(യെശയാവ് 6: 2,3).**

വിശുദ്ധനായ ദൈവം തന്റെ ജനത്തോട് പറയുന്നത് "നിങ്ങളുടെ ദൈവമായ യഹോവ എന്ന ഞാൻ വിശുദ്ധനാകയാൽ നിങ്ങളും വിശുദ്ധരായിരിപ്പിൻ" **(ലേവ്യ 19: 2)** പുറപ്പാടിന്റെ ആരംഭത്തിൽ ദൈവം തന്റെ ജനത്തിനു നൽകിയ വാഗ്ദത്തം, "നിങ്ങൾ എന്നിക്കു പുരോഹിതരാജത്വവും വിശുദ്ധജനവും ആകും. " **(പുറ 19: 6)** എന്നാൽ യാത്രയുടെ അന്ത്യത്തിൽ "നീ അവനു സ്വന്ത ജനമായി അവന്റെ സകലകല്പനകളും പ്രമാണിച്ചു നടക്കുമെന്നും താൻ ഉണ്ടാക്കിയ സകല ജാതികൾക്കും മീതെ നിന്നെ പുകഴ്ച്ചുകൊണ്ടിരിക്കും കീർത്തിക്കും മാനത്തിനുമായി ഉന്നതമാകേണ്ടതിന്

താൻ കല്പിച്ചതുപോലെ നിന്റെ ദൈവമായ യഹോവയ്ക്കു വിശുദ്ധജനമായിരിക്കുമെന്നും' പ്രഖ്യാപിക്കുന്നു (ആവ 26: 18,19) ദൈവീക അധീകാരവും അവന്റെ സാന്നിധ്യവും അനുഭവിക്കണമെങ്കിൽ ദൈവജനം വിശുദ്ധരായിരിക്കുകയും ലോകത്താലുള്ള കളങ്കം പറ്റാതെ പൂർണ്ണമായി ദൈവത്തിനു സമർപ്പിക്കുകയും വേണം.

ദൈവത്തിന്റെ ഈ വിശുദ്ധി ഗായകസംഘവും പങ്കുവെക്കുകയാണ്. അവരുടെ ഇരിപ്പിടവും വേഷവും എല്ലാം ഈ വിശുദ്ധിയെ പ്രകടമാക്കുന്നതാണ്. ദൈവീക പുകഴ്ച്ചക്കായി പാടുന്നതിന് അവർ വിളിക്കപ്പെട്ടവരും വിശുദ്ധീകരിക്കപ്പെട്ടവരും പ്രതിഷ്ഠിക്കപ്പെട്ടവരുമത്രേ. നമ്മെ വിളിച്ചവൻ വിശുദ്ധനായിരിക്കുന്നതുപോലെ നമ്മുടെ സ്വഭാവവും പെരുമാറ്റവുമെല്ലാം വിശുദ്ധമായിരിക്കണം; എല്ലാ മനുഷ്യരോടും സമാധാനമായിരിക്കണം. ഇതുകൂടാതെ ആർക്കും കർത്താവിനെ കാണുവാൻ കഴികയില്ല.

ദൈവത്തിന്റെ സ്വന്തമായതിനാൽ ക്രിസ്ത്യാനി വിശുദ്ധനായിരിക്കണം. ഈ ലോകത്തിൽ വ്യത്യസ്തമായി ജീവിക്കുന്നതിനാണ് വിശുദ്ധി ആവശ്യപ്പെടുന്നത്; ക്രിസ്തുവിനുള്ളവരായി ജീവിക്കണം. ഇത് നമ്മുടെ വാക്കിലും പ്രവർത്തിയിലും പ്രകടമാകണം.

നമ്മുടെ ഗായക സംഘത്തെയും അതിന്റെ എല്ലാ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളെയും ദൈവം അനുഗ്രഹിക്കട്ടെ.

കഴിഞ്ഞ അഞ്ചു മാസങ്ങൾക്കുശേഷം ദൈവാരാധനയ്ക്കായി ഭാഗികമായി നമ്മുടെ പള്ളി തുറക്കുകയാണ്. പള്ളി വീണ്ടും തുറക്കുവാൻ അനുവദിച്ച സർവ്വശക്തനായ ദൈവത്തിന് സ്തോത്രം കരേറ്റുവാൻ ഞാൻ ഈ അവസരം വിനിയോഗിക്കുന്നു. നമ്മുടെ രാജ്യത്തിന്റെ വിശ്വസ്ത പുരന്മാരായി നാം അനുവർത്തിക്കേണ്ട നിയന്ത്രണങ്ങൾ പാലിച്ചുകൊണ്ട് പ്രാർത്ഥനയോടും കൃതജ്ഞതയോടും കൂടെ ദിവ്യാരാധനയിൽ പങ്കെടുക്കുവാൻ ദൈവം നമ്മെ സഹായിക്കട്ടെ.

Christ Church Family Salutes Prof. Dr. P.M. Mathew

Prof. P.M. Mathew (91) Perakathuseril, a very senior member of our congregation has been recently awarded the most prestigious “Doctor of science” degree by the University of Kerala for his life time achievements in the field of Genetics and Cytology.

Prof. P.M. Mathew has served our church as its secretary during 1977-80 and was an active member of Christ Church Fellowship since its inception. He was also the president of the Trivandrum United Christian Prayer Partners Fellowship from 2006.

A brief account of his scientific achievements are as follows:

Prof. P.M Mathew is an eminent Cyto-geneticist with special interest on human and population genetics. He was Professor and Head, Dept. of Botany, University of Kerala during 1989-1990. After graduation in Botany (1952) from Travancore University in first class and first rank and post-graduation by research (1958) in Botany from University of Kerala he did post-doctoral level Research (1966-1968) in U.S.A with Full-bright Fellowship from the University of North Carolina (Population Genetics) and from Wayne State University, Detroit (Human Cytogenetics). He Joined the Department as Lecturer in the year 1956, subsequently served as Reader (1966 – 1978) and Professor (1978 – 1990). He had 34 years of teaching experience including two years of undergraduate teaching in Fatima Matha National College, Kollam and 32 years of

post-graduate teaching in the Department of Botany, University of Kerala. He had 36 years of research experience. His areas of interest include Cytology, Cytogenetics, Biosystematics, Cytotaxonomy, Palynology, Population Genetics, Human Genetics and Human inbreeding. During his service in the Department, 43 students completed their Ph.D. successfully under his supervision. He was instrumental in the submission of Ph.D. theses of 26 other students also. 15 M.Phil. Students carried out their projects under his supervision. 262 publications are to his credit in peer reviewed national and international journals. Seven Books/Monographs are also under his credits. Other publications include Autobiography and Song collections (two). He participated in several conferences/seminars both national- Indian Science Congress - 4 nos. and international including Human Cytogenetics Congress, Detroit, USA (1967) and international Genetic Congress, Tokyo, Japan (1968). He held various prestigious administrative positions in the University of Kerala as Chairman, P.G Board of studies, Chairman, P.G Board of Examiners and Member, Academic Council. He also held office in other professional institutions as Finance Secretary, Environmental Resource Research Centre (ERRC- Thiruvananthapuram), Founder Director, Centre for Multi-Disciplinary Research, Managing Director, ARB Flora Consultancy, Chief Editor, The journal Indian Journal of Botanical Research and Journal of Multi-disciplinary Research and Joint Editor of Journal of Cytology and Genetics. He got Sri Chitra Award for the best scientific work (1960-1962)

and he has been honored with the fellowships FBS and FPnS. He has visited countries like USA, West Indies and Japan for professional purposes. He retired from University service in 1990.

The most inspirational thing is that, he is still active in research, at the age of 91, two papers are under preparation which will be published in 2020.

Being a founder member of Kesavadasapuram Area Prayer Group, a virtual felicitation meeting was arranged to honor him on 8th August 2020 and a memento was presented in a meeting held under the chairmanship of Rev. C. Y. Thomas, Vicar. Very Rev. Matthew Mathew, Rev. Dn. Sam Mathew Roy and Rev. Ninan Jacob also attended the function.

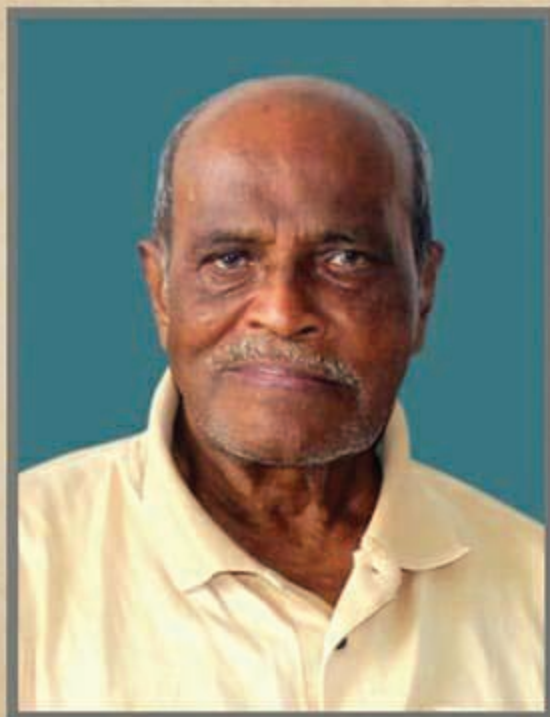

FRUITFULNESS OF THE ELDERLY

“They will still bear fruit in old age; they will stay fresh and green proclaiming the Lord is upright: He is my rock and there is no wickedness in Him”

Psalm 92: 14,15

The world Senior citizens' day is celebrated on 21st August every year. It was first proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly on 14th December 1990. Our church is observing Sunday, 27th September, as Senior citizens' day (Golden Age Fellowship Sunday). This year, it coincides with the CSI formation day-a coincidence which occurs only once in a while.

We all know that old age is tough and full of its limitations like loneliness, weakness of the body, loss of memory, reduced hearing, eyesight etc. But the Bible does not picture old age as a time to be despised. We learn to cope up with the fears and struggles and the growing limitations we face in our day to day lives, but grow stronger inwardly in the midst of these difficulties. We have a large number of assurances in the Bible to strengthen us in our old age. *Isaiah 46: 4* says, “Even to your old age and grey hair I am He, who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you”. We do not know what we are going to face as we advance in our age. But one thing is certain: God will take care of us throughout our lives. *Isaiah 40: 28 - 31* is a great passage of encouragement to the elderly. The everlasting God who is the creator of the ends of the earth gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

In *Isaiah 40: 21* onwards, we see God's power to create, God's provision to sustain and His presence

to help. He cares for each of us personally. He is never too busy to listen to us and to help us. We can always rely on His strength. When we feel that life is crushing us and we are unable to go another step forward, we can call upon God to renew our strength, expecting His promises will help us to rise above life's distractions and difficulties. Trusting in God helps us to remain prepared and patient to hear His word. In **Hebrews 13: 5**, we have the promise, "I will never leave you nor forsake you". So, we can boldly say that God is our refuge

and help and we will not fear. In whatever state we may be, the Lord's hand will lead us and His right hand will hold us tight. (**Psalm 139:10**)

Thanks, should be on our lips every day. When thanksgiving becomes an integral part of our life, we will discover that our attitude towards life changes and we will become more positive, gracious, humble and loving. Palm trees are known for their long life. The cedars of Lebanon grow up to 120 feet in height and up to 30 feet in circumference. They are solid, strong and immovable. In **Psalm 92**, the psalmist sees believers as upright, strong and immovable by the winds of circumstances. Those who place their faith firmly in God can have this strength and vitality. Every breath we take is an opportunity to serve and glorify God. We can have a close relationship with God by reading the Bible and spending time in prayer.

In the Bible, we see many who were called for faithful service in their old age. In the chapter of faith, **Hebrews 11**, we see Abraham and Sarah getting a promised son in their very old age. They believed that the one who promised was faithful. When Moses was tending the flock of Jethro, his father-in-law, in the

desert, the Lord called and appointed him to deliver the Israelites from slavery in Egypt. Moses was very old at that time. He believed in the one who called and obeyed the command. In the New Testament also we see Apostle Paul, who at a very old age while in the prison at Rome, wrote many epistles (called കാരാഗൃഹ ലേഖനങ്ങൾ). Apostle John was over 90 years old when he wrote the last book of the Bible, Revelations. Emperor Domitian had exiled him to the prison island of Patmos for being a Christian. Revelation shows that God will surely triumph over evil.

Our limitations, whatever they may be, are a gift from God. It is with this gift that we are to serve Him. As St. Paul says, "It is in our weakness that God's power can be revealed in us". **II Corinthians 12: 9** reads, "My grace is sufficient for you; for my power is made perfect in weakness." Let us make ourselves available to God for His service rather than feel sorry about ourselves and opt out . Jesus expects His followers to produce fruits. In **John 15**: God is portrayed as a good gardener who trims and cleans every branch so that it will produce more fruits. In **Galatians 5: 22,23**, we read about the fruits of the spirit. What God wants from us, rather *for* us, is a life filled with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Though the trimming process is painful, we can see that the things that are cut away are of our sinful nature like hatred, jealousy, arrogance, bad relationships and the like. **Ecclesiastes 3: 1** says that God does everything beautiful in its time. But we can never understand completely what He is doing. We must submit our life to God, believing it will lead to bearing of more fruits. People are watching the way we act rather than listening to what we speak. People

must know we are Christians not because of the name we bear, but because of the life we live. What would others say about our lives?

In **Colossians 1: 10**, we see that we have to live a life worthy of the Lord and please Him in every way, bearing fruit in every work and growing in the knowledge of God. The love God expects from us is far beyond the standards of this world. In the letter of St. Paul to Philemon, we read that Paul wanted a special favour of a rich friend named Philemon. Onesimus, a slave of Philemon, had stolen some property and had run away. Later Onesimus met St. Paul in prison and became a Christian. St Paul asks Philemon to forgive Onesimus and to accept him as a brother. St. Paul urges Philemon to offer grace rather than demand justice, and Philemon acts according to the wish of St. Paul. Here we can see that tactful persuasion accomplishes a great deal more than commands when dealing with people. Christian relationship should be full of forgiveness and acceptance. St. Paul depicts a good example of how to deal with a possible conflict between Christian friends. In **Matthew 6: 12**, we read that as Christians we must forgive others as we have been forgiven. **Ephesians 4: 32** says, "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other just as in Christ, God forgave you. The manner in which we treat our brothers and sisters in Christ's family reflects our Christian commitment.

In **Ephesians 4: 1 - 12**, we are instructed to walk worthy of the calling with which we were called, bearing with one another in love. Are we able to forgive those who have done wrong to us?

Advances in medical science are making it possible

for more and more people to live longer. But none of us can avoid growing old. What is preventable is an attitude of bitterness and regret as we grow older. Look at the life of Moses. When he was 120 years old, he stood with the Israelites to see the promised land after leading them for forty years in the wilderness. He could not enter the promised land because he had disobeyed the Lord when in anger, he struck the rock in the wilderness (**Numbers 20: 11,12,24**). Yet he did not slip into self-pity. At the end of his life, he praised the Lord and urged the new generation of Israel to obey God. As we grow older, we can either dwell on the failures and hardships of our past or we can remember God's faithfulness, accept His discipline and keep looking to the future in faith. It is the only way to avoid a bitter attitude.

Always praise God for His love and care. **Philippians 4: 4** says Rejoice in the Lord always. Then instead of complaining about the thorns we will be grateful about the roses. In **Nehemiah 8: 10**, we see, "The **Joy** of the Lord is my strength". No matter what happens, we can find joy in the Lord. People who look beyond their present difficulties and put their trust in God's goodness cannot help but be joyful. In **John 15: 11**, we read, "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete".

James 3: 18 "Peace makers who sow in peace raise a harvest of righteousness". Wherever we are at present, we must ask the Lord to use us as peacemakers. The best peacemakers are those who know the peace of God which surpasses all understanding. When we are battered by the storms of life we may be tempted to give in to feelings of

hopelessness, but if we look to our sovereign captain and commit our ways to Him, we will find **Peace** even in the midst of turmoil. We can trust him to bring us through the storm.

We must exhibit **Faith** in the power of God, in the presence of God, in the promises of God and in the purpose of God about our life. When the God of grace controls our lives, we can transform interruptions into opportunities, failures into successes, pride into humility and suffering into strength.

In **Romans 5: 3**, we can see that we rejoice in our sufferings because suffering produces perseverance, perseverance produces character and character produces **Hope**.

Do we prayerfully encourage those around us by our spirit-enabled cheerfulness, our courage and confidence in God? When we rely on the Lord, He will help us to turn pain into praise. Christ is risen from the dead. If we trust in Christ as our Saviour, Jesus's resurrection gives us a sure **Hope** of our own resurrection.

The Lord can use us to encourage and strengthen each other. Many believe that the present pandemic COVID 19 is God's call to His people to return to Him. We are expected to spend more time in prayer and to study the Word of God to know His purpose about us.

As believers in Jesus, it is our privilege to show love and concern for others through acts of kindness. We know that a shared joy is a double joy, shared sorrow is half a sorrow (Swedish proverb). At this time of the

pandemic, we are unable to visit the sick and the people in grief. But we can pray for them and comfort them through a telephone call. We are staying safe and healthy not because of our merit, but because of the prayers of many others. For those who grow old with God, their old age will be full of tranquillity, courage and kindness.

Let us thank God for His faithfulness throughout our life and pray God to help us to finish our life in service to Him and to remember that old age does not mean uselessness.

A chorus from a hymn written by Daniel Webster Whittle is as follows:

“Moment by Moment, I am kept in His love
Moment by Moment, I have life from above
Looking to Jesus till glory doth shine
Moment by Moment, O Lord, I am thine”

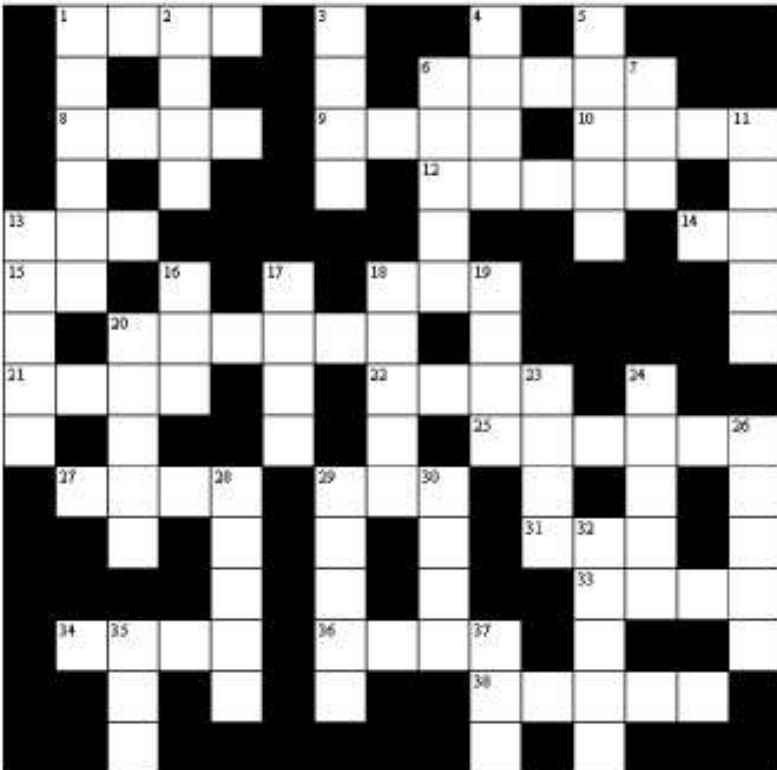

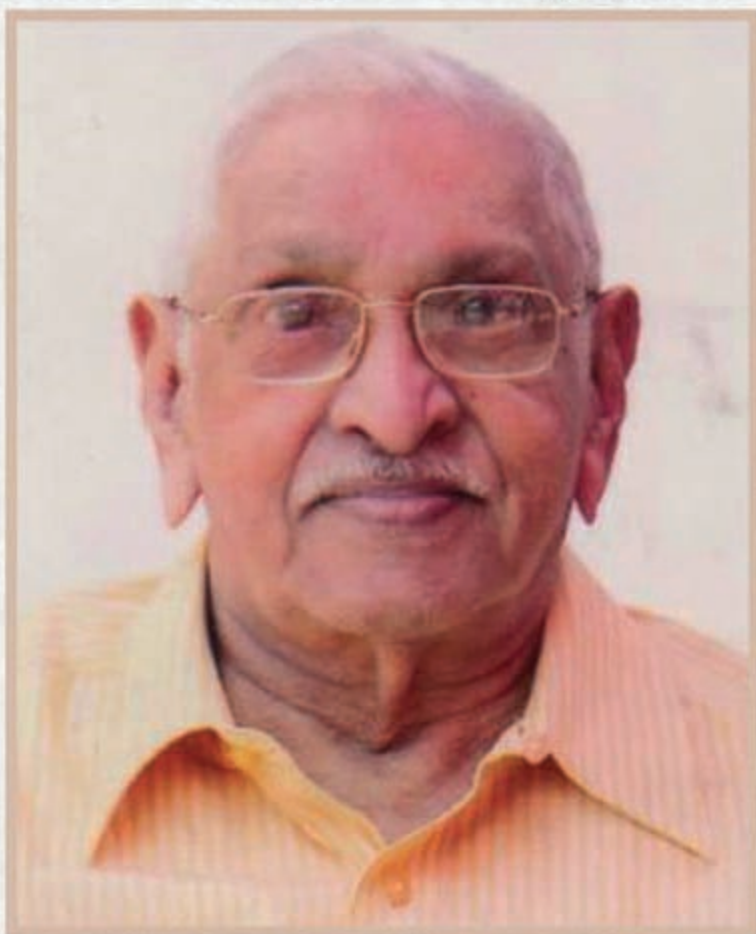
