Beloved in Christ,

Greetings to you all in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Once again, we are in a lockdown due to the heavy spread of Covid19. During these difficult times, we need the guidance of God. In Psalms 25, David points out that we can experience God's guidance if we meet certain spiritual conditions.

1. Confidence. We give evidence of our confidence in God through worship. We need to pray so that we have our hearts right with him. Another evidence of our confidence is the witness of the Word. Waiting is another evidence. If we rush ahead, we will get into trouble. When we have big decisions to make, we must wait and spend time in the scriptures.

2. Penitence. David is sorry for his sins. He wants God to remember His tender mercies, not David's transgressions. God never forgets his children. David asks God for mercy because he is concerned about his past sins and he does not want those sins to get him off target.

4. Reverence. God will guide us in our choices, if we

5. Perseverance It is not always easy to know and do the will of God. Sometimes when we are seeking the Lord, circumstances get worse and we become lonely. David was lonely and afflicted, but he remembered that God was with him. Because of that, he maintained his integrity and obedience.

Let us submit before God and pray to Him to guide us, especially during this pandemic time.

കോവിഡ് 19 ന്റെ അതിവ്യാപനം മൂലം നാം ഒരിക്കൽ കൂടെ ലോക്ക്ഡൗണിലാണ്. ഈ പ്രയാസമേറിയ സന്ദർഭത്തിൽ ദൈവീകനടത്തിപ്പ് നമുക്കണിവാശ്യമാണ്. ചില ആത്മീയ വ്യവസ്ഥകൾ നാം പാലിച്ചെങ്കിലേ ദൈവീകനടത്തിപ്പ് അനുഭവിക്കുവാൻ കഴിയുകയുള്ളൂ എന്ന് 25ം സങ്കീർത്തനത്തിൽ സങ്കീർത്തനക്കാരനായ ദാവീദ് ചൂണ്ടിക്കാട്ടുന്നു.

1. ആത്മവിശ്വാസം.

ആരാധനയിലൂടെ ദൈവത്തിലുള്ള നമ്മുടെ ആത്മ വിശ്വാസമാണ് വെളിച്ചമുണ്ടാക്കുന്നത്. ദൈവവുമായി

ശരിയായ ബന്ധം നിലനിർത്തുന്നതിന് നാം പ്രാർത്ഥിക്കേണ്ടത് ആവശ്യമാണ്. അതുപോലെ ദൈവീക സമയത്തിനായി കാത്തിരിക്കണം. ദൈവീകസമയത്തിനു മുമ്പേ നാം പോകുന്നുവെങ്കിൽ പ്രശ്നത്തിൽ അകപ്പെടും. ദൈവവചനത്തിന്റെ ഉറപ്പാണ് നമ്മുടെ ആത്മവിശ്വാസത്തിന്റെ മറ്റൊരു തെളിവ്. പ്രധാന തീരുമാനങ്ങൾ എടുക്കുമ്പോൾ തിരുവചനത്തിൽ നാം സമയം ചെലവഴിക്കണം.

2. അനുതാപം

ദൈവീക നടത്തിപ്പ് ലഭിക്കുന്നതിനുള്ള മറ്റൊരു വ്യവസ്ഥ അനുതാപമാണ്. തന്റെ പാപങ്ങളെക്കുറിച്ച് ദാവീദ് അനുതപിച്ചു. തന്റെ അകൃത്യത്തെക്കുറിച്ച് ഓർക്കാതെ, ദൈവം തന്റെ ദയ നിമിത്തം തന്നെ ഓർക്കുവാൻ ദാവീദ് ആഗ്രഹിക്കുന്നു. ദൈവം തന്റെ മക്കളെ ഒരിക്കലും മറക്കുകയില്ല. തന്റെ ബാല്യകാല പാപങ്ങളെക്കുറിച്ച് ഓർക്കുന്ന ദാവീദ് ദൈവത്തിന്റെ കരുണയ്ക്കായി യാചിക്കുന്നു. തന്റെ കഴിഞ്ഞകാല പാപങ്ങളാൽ ലക്ഷ്യത്തിൽ നിന്ന് ഒഴിവാക്കപ്പെടുവാൻ അവൻ ആഗ്രഹിക്കുന്നില്ല - ദൈവമേ, നിന്റെ കൃപപ്രകാരം, നിന്റെ ദയ നിമിത്തം എന്നെ ഓർക്കണമേ.

3. അനുസരണം

മറ്റൊരു വ്യവസ്ഥ അനുസരണമാണ്. നാം എല്ലാവരും പാപികളാണ്. നാം പൂർണ്ണരാകുമ്പോഴല്ല, അനുസരിക്കുമ്പോഴാണ് ദൈവീക നടത്തിപ്പ് ലഭിക്കുന്നത്. ദൈവവചനം നാം അനുസരിക്കുമ്പോൾ, അടുത്തപടി അവൻ നമുക്ക് കാണിച്ചുതരും. ദൈവീകനടത്തിപ്പ് ഒരു 'സ്പോട്ട് ലൈറ്റ് അല്ല' പ്രത്യുത ഓരോ ചുവടിനും പ്രകാശം നൽകുന്ന വിളക്കാണ്.

4. ദൈവത്തോടുള്ള ഭക്തി

ദൈവത്തോടുള്ള ഭക്തി നാം പ്രദർശിപ്പിക്കണം. നാം

3. ഓൺലൈൻ വി. ബി. എസ്.

Thought for the Month

Charles Thomas Studd (C T Studd.) an English man, was born in 1860, one of three sons of a wealthy retired planter. He was educated at Eton and Cambridge, a very famous cricketer, very rich, lived in a palatial mansion, gave up everything, went to Africa, made a small hut with his own hands and preached the Gospel of Life and Love to the tribal people on the northern darkest regions of Africa. He was a servant of Christ who faithfully served His Saviour in China, India, and Africa. When someone said "What a great sacrifice" Studds' reply is our thought for this month.

"If Jesus Christ is God and died for me, then no sacrifice can be too great for me to make for Him"

**Worker's rights, Worker's Day and
Workers with God**

Before we ponder over our theme for the month, I think it is necessary to glance through some historical events that necessitated the recognition of worker's rights in the developed and developing nations around the globe.

Inequalities and racism

"I have a dream that one day this nation will rise up and live out the true meaning of its creed...that all men are created equal...one day former slaves and slave owners will be able to sit down together at the table of brotherhood." This is an excerpt from a public speech that was delivered by American civil rights activist, Martin Luther King Jr. at Washington during the march for jobs and freedom on August 28, 1963. The call was for civil and economic rights and an end to racism. Martin was shot dead by one of his enemies on April 4, 1968 and his dream has never become fully true.

Key words and definitions

Oxford dictionary defines the word **slave** as a person who is owned by another person and is forced to work for him. A **worker** is defined as a person who does a particular kind of work in a farm, factory, office, construction site, hospital etc. A **labourer** is a person whose job involves hard physical work that is mostly unskilled, especially done outdoors. A slave does not have the privilege of being paid like the other workers.

The system of slavery started as early as 3500 BC in the first Sumer civilization in Mesopotamia (now southern Iraq). War, poverty and famine were the main driving forces for this evil practice. The mighty and

powerful people took property from the earth for themselves and started using slaves. The role of today's big machines was done by slaves. Most of the wonders of the world (The Pyramids, The Great Wall of China etc.) were built by slaves. The Israelites were slaves in Egypt before they were liberated by God through Moses. In the Bible, those who became slaves due to debts were to be treated with respect (Leviticus 25:39). Attempts to stop slavery can be seen in Nehemiah 5:1-13. Slavery was first banned in 1803 in the European country, Denmark. In the US, slavery was abolished in 1865. Despite the fact that slavery is prohibited worldwide, modern forms of the sinister practice still persist in different forms – debt bondage in Asia, forced labour in gulf states, child labour for agriculture in Africa and Latin American countries – all numbering around 40 million.

Class struggle

Class struggle happens when the rich business class hires the working class to make things for them to sell. The workers have no say in their pay or whatever things they make, since they are at the mercy of their bosses, having come to earn a living. Those who own and run business made huge profits which were the result of the hard manual labour of the working class. The benefits from the profits were not shared well with workers. Daring to ask for bonus often resulted in the termination of the job. During and after the Industrial Revolution, machines were owned by bosses and the workers produced the different items. The bosses made money by buying the time and energy of the workers engaged in production. Struggle against the ruling class for labourer's rights happened in many places

during the last centuries and is still going on. The true democratic system with all its ideals practically never exists anywhere.

World Worker's Day

May 1 (May Day) is celebrated by the working class worldwide as International Worker's Day. During the second part of the 19th century, there were revolutions by industrial workers in Germany, France, England and the US demanding for the reduction in the working time from 12 – 15 hours to 8 hours. Historically, one particular event is referred to as the origin of May 1 as Worker's Day. On May 4, 1886, labourers assembled at the Haymarket Square in Chicago and took a rally demanding '8 hours working day'. A bomb exploded among the crowd, followed by police firing and 11 lives were lost. Many of the agitators who were protesting against the violations of worker's rights, long work hours, poor working conditions, low wages and child labour were arrested and sentenced for life imprisonment and some were served death sentence. The incident sparked off a series of worldwide protests demanding the recognition of worker's rights. In India, under the leadership of Singaravelar, leader of the Labour Kisan Party of Hindusthan, meetings were held in Madras, near the High Court and Triplicane beach in 1923. A resolution was passed, urging the British Government to declare May 1 as Labour day and a Government holiday.

Labourers in The Bible

In the background of the world's labour scene which I briefly presented here, how should we, the believers in Jesus Christ, perform our duties? Paul says in 1 Cor. 3:9 "For we are co-workers in God's service; you are

God's field, God's building" and in 1 Cor. 3:6: "I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow." While the text is primarily spoken in the apostolic and evangelical work of the early teachers, the principle implied in the verses is very wide and it applies to all areas of life and activity – intellectual, scholastic, philanthropic and social. Every workplace can be converted into a place of service to the society, if the workers impart the virtues of sincerity, loyalty, integrity, equal respect to all classes of people and faithfulness in the given job. But according to the New Testament teaching, the highest form in which we can cooperate with God is the carrying out of The Great Commission, spreading the good news of salvation and calling of disciples for Jesus Christ. (Matthew 28:19, 20). "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." (Matthew 6:33).

The labourers in the kingdom of the prince of this world (devil) are denied of their rights, proper wages and rest. In the garden of Eden over and above the abundance given by God, Eve was lured by the devil to eat the forbidden fruit to become equal with God. Because the fallen prince motivates people to be greedy to earn more and more, they never get satisfied of their thirst and lust. Hence more evil plans are plotted to exploit others to meet their own goals. Slavery, bondage, denial of rights, lack of freedom and exploitation are all characteristics of the devil's kingdom.

Workers in God's field

In the kingdom of God, He selects people according to their skills for specific jobs as in the example of the builders of the Tabernacle (Exodus 35 & 36). All of God's

creation is God's property and should be used for the purposes for which God created it. (Psalm 104). God provides food in due season to every creature proportional to their need and not greed. His provision is all around us. We need wisdom and effort to gather it (manna- Exodus 16:15,16). Working for the Lord also means doing good deeds and helping the poor as in the example of Tabitha in Acts 9:36-43. Not only did she regain her life by Peter's command but also caused many to be drawn to faith in the Lord.

When God sends you to a specific task, the commission of the sender is the first priority (John 4:34). There are many people waiting and ready to come to God's kingdom. Disciples are reapers (workers) in that harvest. Their work would be rewarded. The fruit of this labour would last forever; every reaper and sower would rejoice together (John 4:36). In God's work someone sows the seed and another one reaps the harvest (1 Cor.3:6-8). No matter whoever sows or whoever reaps, the harvest brings glory to God. The work of the church is like that of a gardener. Patience, vision and faith are required. We may not see the results now, but a rich harvest can be awaited.

Prayer: Father in Heaven, unite us under your umbrella of love and help us to see each other as equals created in your own image. Wherever you may place us, mould us to be instruments of the Good News and be faithful witnesses of our calling. Help us to do your will, working along with you as builders of your kingdom and grant us citizenship of the same now and for evermore.

Christ Church Covid and Disaster Relief Fund (CCCDRF)

An urgent meeting of the Church Committee was convened on 15/05/2021, to discuss immediate relief measures to be undertaken during this period of Covid pandemic and natural calamities, in concurrence with our Government and Diocese.

It was decided to constitute "Christ Church Covid and Disaster Relief Fund (CCCDRF)" immediately and to undertake the following relief measures:

- ◆ Contribute medical kits worth Rs.50000/- to Covid clinic in General Hospital,
- ◆ Contribute Rs.2000/- each to 50 deserving families of our outstation churches,
- ◆ Contribute Rs.5000/- each to 6 helpers in Adoor district,
- ◆ Distribute grocery kits to migrant workers attending Hindi Worship Service,
- ◆ Supply food packets to members of our church where all family members turn Covid positive
- ◆ Give support to people affected by natural calamities
- ◆ Contribute Rs.50000/- to Bishop's Covid Relief Fund as first instalment

It was decided to constitute a Guidance Cell comprising the Diocesan Council members, area conveners and doctor members of our church to provide guidance and possible assistance/support to Covid affected families identified by respective area conveners.

It was also decided to mobilize funds urgently from our church members, to carry out these activities on extreme humanitarian grounds.

The Story of My Son's Wedding

Our God intensely loves us and deeply cares for us. He provides all that we need at the right time. He has a plan for every one of us – when and where we would be born, what our tasks would be and even where we would settle down. [Jeremiah 29:11, Acts 17:26]

During the year 2019, we celebrated our daughter's wedding on the 26th of December 2019. It was our fond hope and prayer that God would enable us to organize our eldest son Jai's wedding also soon afterwards. The hitch was we did not know who was going to be the bride. We were praying and waiting on God to show us the girl chosen by Him. Our daughter's wedding was to be solemnized in Chennai Egmore Wesley Church, and consequently for most of 2019, my wife and I were busy shuttling between Chennai and Trivandrum regarding the arrangements. As the wedding day approached, we were so busy with the preparations that we found little time to think about our son's marriage.

On 9th November, about six weeks prior to our daughter's wedding, a family whom we never met before, paid a surprise visit to our home with their daughter and we knew that God was working behind the scenes to show us the bride chosen by Him for our son. Surely, God fulfils the desires of those who fear Him. [Psalm 145:19] Jai was in the USA and had changed his job just 4 months earlier, and therefore was unable to travel to India to attend his sister's wedding or to meet with the prospective bride and her family. The grace of God was evident, as the prospective groom and bride were able to seal their agreement after just a couple of videocalls. The families chose June 24, 2020 as the date of the wedding, giving ample time for proper planning. Unfortunately, when the year 2020 dawned the Covid-19 pandemic

struck, travel across international borders shut down. US Embassies worldwide pulled down their shutters for non-citizen services. Our son required stamping of the US Visa to be able to return to the USA after his wedding. We know, no plan of God can be thwarted. Surely, He can do all things. [Job 42: 2] The children and the parents had to simply wait for God to move. We had to choose a new date for the wedding.

After much prayer, we chose 15th Jan 2021 for Jai's return to India. It was almost nine years since Jai left for the USA to pursue higher studies. So, we too were eager to see him. We had no idea however, when Jai would be able to get appointment with the US Embassy, for passport stamping to facilitate his return. The wedding was set to 3rd February 2021. His travel to India had to be approved at the highest levels in his company because of the Covid -19 situation. The company was also very considerate. Jai arrived safely on the 17th of January 2021 and God enabled us to celebrate Jai's wedding on 3rd February in a solemn and beautiful manner observing all the government guidelines and with a small audience of select friends and relatives. We also had a thanksgiving prayer service on open lawns to close the wedding celebrations. By the grace of God no one fell ill, and everyone returned home happily.

If the newly married couple must travel to USA, the American Embassy needed to stamp both their passports. The planned return date was 12th March 2021. During the Covid-19 pandemic the American Embassy and Consulates had their own operating procedures and obtaining an appointment looked elusive. The US President Donald Trump had paused the stamping of H1B visas until 31st March 2021. Ultimately, a window opened at the New Delhi Embassy for Mid-April and Jai fixed the return travel date to the USA as 21st April. The second Covid wave was starting in India as

Jai and his wife Mona travelled to Delhi for their visa interview. Delhi was under night curfew as a precautionary step. The LORD protected them, granted them favour with the US Embassy and brought them safely back to Trivandrum. Mona's passport reached us at 9 PM on the 20th. Jai's passport had arrived earlier on 18th April. The children left for USA on the morning of 21st April. We later learnt that the US Embassy at New Delhi had cancelled appointments from 20th April onwards and that United Airlines also cancelled their flights to India from 22nd April. (Subsequently, the airline has resumed from 25th April, but the Embassy is yet to resume visa interviews.)

Why did I write this short story? It is only to acknowledge the wonderful deeds of our God who plans beautiful events for His children even during difficult seasons and carries them out to perfection. On our own we could have done nothing. There were so many things to go wrong. Both the USA and our country are severely affected by Covid-19. If any of the RT-PCR tests at any step had been positive or if any close family member had been affected the whole plan would have crashed. Getting a visa appointment at the US Embassy was a big unknown impacting our son's job. At every step we had been praying before taking a decision. Many friends and our own family supported us in their ardent prayers for us and for Jai specifically. God is faithful. His mercies are new every morning. (Lamentations 3:23) God who did not spare His own Son for us, how will He not graciously grant the simple prayers of His children. (Romans 8:32) Those who look up to Him are never ashamed. Their faces are radiant. (Psalm 34:5)

I wrote down this brief account of my son's wedding as a rejoinder to one of our friends congratulating us on achieving the impossible. We take no credit because we did not or could not do anything about the

circumstances. All praise and glory be to the one true God who cares for us and sent His only Son to the cross as the vicarious sacrifice to reconcile all mankind to Him.
